The Race will consist of 24 teams who will all compete in a heat style format in order to qualify for the final. The top six times will advance to the final and run a fresh run.

All entries for the Draft/Mule Feed Team Race will be due by the entry closing deadline. There is no limit to how many teams an owner can submit. Every team submitted will pay a non-refundable \$25 processing fee. One spot will be designated for the previous year's winner should they have a team to enter. All owners will have one entry submitted into an initial draw. If there are remaining spots, the owners with multiple teams will be added to the draw to fill the final spots and an alternate list. Class entry fees will be processed following the draw for those selected.
