ANGUS PEN BULL SHOW

Exhibitors who participate in shows that accept premium monies contributed by the American Angus Association are subject to the Association Rules as found in the Breeders' Reference Guide of the Association. The rules relating directly with the exhibition of Angus cattle are Part 2: Association Rules; Rule 800 Series; including Rule 800-810. These rules can be found at www.angus.org.

ANIMALS ENTERED IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED AND SHOWN BY THE ORIGINAL BREEDER OR FIRST OWNER. All carloads and pens of bulls will be weighed prior to entering the ring and average weights will be calculated. **Exhibitors must designate alternate bulls at check-in to the American Angus Association Pen and Carload Superintendent. If an alternate is to be used, following check-in, it can only be done in the case of death, unsoundness or sickness. This must be approved by the Association superintendent.** The decision of the superintendent is final. Bulls must be loose when exhibited. **Registration numbers must be on entry form.**

Entries to the Angus Association bull sale may be added from those carload and pen divisions that will add quality and strength to their entire sale, at the discretion of the American Angus Association staff and their sale manager(s).

Classes will be broken after arrival and processing according to the average age in days. Class designation is calculated on the average age of the bulls in the pen. Bulls may be no more than 30 days older or younger than the age classification specified for the class.

Total premium money is \$6,000, 50% paid by the American Angus Association and 50% paid by the National Western Stock Show. First place in each individual class will receive \$300 and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis, through sixth place, among the other entries exhibited after the show has been completed. Premium checks will be mailed directly from National Western Stock Show offices.

ANGUS PEN HEIFER SHOW

Exhibitors who participate in shows that accept premium monies contributed by the American Angus Association are subject to the Association Rules as found in the Breeders' Reference Guide of the Association. The rules relating directly with the exhibition of Angus cattle are Part 2: Association Rules; Rule 800 Series; including Rule 800-810. These rules can be found at www.angus.org.

Animals entered in the following classes must be entered and shown by the original breeder or first owner. All carloads and pens of heifers will be weighed prior to entering the ring and average weights will be calculated. **Exhibitors must designate alternate bulls at check-in to the American Angus Association Pen and Carload Superintendent. If an alternate is to be used, following check-in, it can only be done in the case of death, unsoundness or sickness. This must be approved one hour before the time of the show, by the Association superintendent.** The decision of the superintendent is final. Heifers must be loose when exhibited. **Registration numbers must be on entry form.**

Classes will be broken after arrival and processing according to the average age in days. Class designation is calculated on the average age of the heifers in the pen. Heifers may be no more than 30 days older or younger than the age classification specified for the class.

Total premium money is \$1000.00, paid by the American Angus Association. First place in each individual class will receive \$150 and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis, through sixth place, among the other entries exhibited after the show has been completed. Premium checks will be mailed directly from National Western Stock Show offices.
