National Bison Association (NBA) will collect entry forms and entry fees.

A Consignor must be a NBA member prior to the sale. **All bison registered with the North American Bison Registry will be exempt from any additional age certification. All consignors will be allowed 2 entries per class with the exception of the pen of 5 heifer calves, in which entries will be limited to one per consignor, and the individual calf classes, in which entries are allowed up to three per consignor.** A certificate of veterinary inspection is required for each individual class and/or animal entry, plus FOUR copies of each certificate. Brucellosis testing: A negative blood test is required on all animals, except Official Calfhood Vaccinate (OCV) heifer calves. Tuberculosis Testing: All animals require a negative TB test. Anaplasmosis & Bluetongue: optional. Ivermectin: All animals must be injected with Ivermectin 10 to 12 days prior to the sale. All breeding age females must be pregnancy tested. An acceptable test performed by a licensed veterinarian includes palpitation, blood test or ultra sound. Yearling Heifers are required to be open and this should be indicated on the health certificate along with observation date. Fertility Testing: All breeding age bulls must have a semen test on or after October 16, 2018. **BVD testing: All bison must show a negative test for BVD-PI (persistently infected) before entering the show grounds.** For a complete set of Rules and Regulations please contact the NBA office at 303-292-2833 or go to www.bisoncentral.com.

CLASSES: No minimum weights required for class entries.

CARCASS CLASS:

The maximum age for the female carcass class will be 33 months.
The maximum age for the male carcass class will be 30 months.
The maximum number of entries per Market Class is two.
The Maximum number of entries for the Market Class is 40.

Trophies will be awarded for 1st through 3rd, with honorable mention, unless there are more than 10 head in a class, in which 4th and 5th place will be awarded. All winners will be announced at the National Bison Association banquet being held at the Denver Renaissance Hotel on Friday, January 25, 2019. The National Bison Association's annual Conference (Hotel) and Gold Trophy Show & Sale (GTSS) will be held January 23-26, 2019.
