1. National Western Stock Show will collect an entry fee of fiftyfive (\$55.00) dollars per head entered plus a ten (\$10.00) dollar administrative fee, with fee and entry mailed directly to National Western Stock Show offices or enter online at [www.nationalwestern.com](http://www.nationalwestern.com). All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States funds.

2. All entries must be Registered or eligible to be Registered with the AGBA. 3. Classes listed are general classification only. The individual classes will be determined and divided after the cattle are checked in at the show.

4. All entries will be weighted and measured (hip height, feet set by handler's approval of placement) at check-in, any animals not processed will not be eligible to show. To minimize variation in data collection, one individual will collect data on all entries. After animals have left initial processing, they may be re-measured once with the payment of \$25 per head at the time of re-measurement. The second measurement is final and will replace original measurement. Re-measurement will only be done at conclusion of regular processing.

5. Substitutions may only be made with entries of the same sex and class; and to be submitted to the superintendent, no later than Jan. 10th.

6. Premiums will be paid through 3rd place in each class. First place in each individual class will receive fifty (\$50) dollars and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated scale to 2nd and 3rd place after the show has been completed.

7. National Western Stock Show awards ribbons to winners in each class through 5th place, rosettes to all Division Champions and Reserve Champions and banners to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.

To be eligible to show in Galloway Percentage Show animals must have one registered Galloway parent. Either the sire or the dam of the entry must be 100% Galloway – registered with the AGBA. The show is governed by the same rules as the Galloway Show.

**AGBA YOUTH SHOW**

**Junior show is governed by same rules as Open Galloway show. Questions about the classes or participation should be directed to Shawn Schumacher, 406-799-0276. Junior division: Age requirement - 5 yrs. old up to 21. Junior entries can be either owned or leased. Animals exhibited must be registered with the AGBA, but are not required to be exhibited in the Galloway Open show. \*\*Junior classes will follow the same class break-out and entries shall be identified with a prefix ("Jr"). Example- { Jr101. – Youth Class – Heifers calved after July 1, 2018. }**

**PREMIER EXHIBITOR:**

Ties will be broken by final placing in four head group. Points in all classes (Except classes 401-503) and divisions will be awarded to owners or co-owners who receive premium monies.

**PREMIER BREEDER:** Awarded to the Breeder of Record, regardless of current ownership of entry, with highest total points. Point system same as Premier Exhibitor.

**HERDSMAN AWARD:** Ballot voting by exhibitors at cattle check-in. One ballot per exhibitor allowed. Tie breaker will be chosen by superintendent.

**CARCASS CHAMPION:** Awarded to the top combined ultrasound data.
