1. Each exhibitor in this show will pay a fee of seventy-seven dollars (\$77.00) per head entered. From this fee, forty dollars (\$40.00) must be mailed to the National Western Stock Show or enter online at www.natinalwestern.com as a standard entry fee for breeding cattle and thirty seven dollars (\$37.00) must be mailed along with a copy of the entry form to the American Salers Association, Attn: Sherry Doubet, 19590 East Mainstreet #104, Parker, CO 80139 as a show fee. All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States funds.

2. All animals exhibited must be recorded in the name of the exhibitor on or before November 1, 2018.

3. All animals must be registered with American Salers Association or the Salers Association of Canada . All animals must be properly tattooed and will be inspected at the show. Tattoos must be legible and must match the registration papers, which will be checked at the show.

4. All entries must be made on regular entry forms obtained from the National Western Stock Show.

5. Exhibitors are subject to all rules and health regulations of the American Salers Association and the National Western Stock Show as set forth in this premium book.

6. The American Salers Association will host two shows in conjunction with the National Western Stock Show. (The Salers show will be for 87.5% to fullblood bulls and females. The Optimizer show will be for 50% to 87.4% Salers bulls and females.)

7. No exhibitors, individuals assisting exhibitors or member owners shall be allowed to use any coloring agents on any animal exhibited. All Division Champions and Reserve Champions will be tested with the white towel test prior to entering the champion line-up.

8. ASA will follow the National Western Stock Show protest rule.

PREMIUMS:

A: First place in each individual class will receive one hundred (\$100.00) dollars and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduating basis through 5th place after the show. The National Western Stock Show awards ribbons to all winners in each class through 7th place, rosettes to all Division Champions and Reserve Division Champions and banners to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.

NATIONAL SALERS SHOW (continued)

NOTE: 1 At NWSS for classes 101, 102, 103 and 104 in the heifers and classes 201, 202, 203 and 204 in the bulls, in the cases of ten (10) head or more being present at the show, the classes will be divided into two (2) classes of equal number.

NOTE: 2 Entries in classes 108 and 109 and 208 and 209 will be combined and shown in one (1) class unless there are six (6) head or more present at the show. In case of six (6) head or more being present at the show, the classes will be divided by age into two (2) classes of equal number.

NOTE: 3 Animals from the Salers Division and the Optimizer Division are eligible to participate in the group classes.

GROUP CLASSES

JOS Junior Get-Of-Sire - Three (3) animals shown in above single entry classes of Senior calves and younger, progeny of one (1) sire, must include both sexes.

GOS Get-Of-Sire - Four (4) animals shown in above single entry classes, progeny of one (1) sire, must include both sexes.

POD Produce-Of-Dam - Two (2) animals shown in above single entry classes, either or both sexes from the same dam.

B5H Best Five Head – All five (5) head must be bred and owned or co-owned by one (1) exhibitor.

Premier Exhibitor

The American Salers Association will present a banner to the Premier Exhibitor of the show. Points will be awarded to the person entering and exhibiting the animal including immediate family ownership such as children or grandchildren, with the winner being determined by the individual animal's placement within individual classes. Points will be awarded as follows: three (3) points for each 1st: two (2) points for each 2nd: and one (1) point for each 3rd. Points will be divided on multiple-owned cattle according to the present of ownership. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine the winner shall be limited to five (5) that total the most number of points. In case of a tie, additional placements beyond five (5) will be used until a winner is determined.

Premier Breeder

The American Salers Association will present a banner to the Premier Breeder of the show. Exhibitors in contention are the registered breeders of record or immediate family members, this includes children or grandchildren. A winner will be determined by the breeder's placement in the individual classes only, as follows: three (3) points for each 1st: two (2) points for each 2nd: and one (1) point for each 3rd. Points will be divided on multiple-owned cattle according to the present of ownership. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine the winner shall be limited to five (5) that total the most number of points. In case of a tie, additional placements beyond five (5) will be used until a winner is determined.

OPTIMIZER SHOW

Optimizer Division - Breed percentages and other rules as previously listed. The Optimizer show classes will be broken upon arrival. Noted above under group classes.
