NATIONAL WESTERN STOCK SHOW\$6,500

1. National Western Stock Show will collect an entry fee of fifty-five (\$55.00) dollars per head entered plus a ten (\$10.00) dollar administrative fee with fee and entry mailed directly to National Western Stock Show offices or enter online at www.nationalwestern.com. All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States funds.

2. All animals entered in the National Aberdeen Show must be registered with the American Aberdeen Association. Exhibitors must have proof of registration at the time of check in at National Western Stock Show. There will be a Fullblood show and a Percentage/Purebred (1/2, 3/4, 7/8, etc.) show. Group classes can contain both Percentage or Purebred and Fullblood cattle in the same group and will all compete against each other.

3. Proof of satisfactory semen evaluation for bulls born prior to September 1, 2018 must be submitted at the time of check-in.

4. Cattle must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership at the time of the show entry deadline. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in the individual classes.

5. All animals must be properly tattooed and will be inspected at the show. Tattoo must be legible and must match registration papers.

6. All cattle must meet the health requirements set out by the Show Management. Any deviation will be just cause for immediate disqualification from the show.

7. All bulls born before September 1, 2018 must show with a noselead. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the show committee.

8. Any female with a calf at side, irregardless of age, must show in the Cow-Calf class. All females born before August 31, 2017 must be shown with calf at side. All females born September 1, 2017 through April 30, 2018 must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of safe in calf will apply to: 1.) a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian or 2.) females shown with calf at side.

9. All females shown in the cow/calf classes with a calf over 150 days must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the safe in calf rule will apply to a donor female that has produced eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified by a written statement from a licensed veterinarian.

10. Cow-Calf classes – Any female with a calf at side, irregardless of age, must show in the Cow-Calf class. Calf must be cow's natural calf. Cows that are exhibited with calves at the side must be lactating to calves born on or after May 1, 2019 and must be nursing. Calf entries in the Cow-Calf class may be shown individually providing individual entry has been made. Cows may be evaluated and screened out of the show on the basis of udder quality. The determination of the show committee will be final.

11. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation, or not abiding by the show rules, will be disqualified and denied the privilege of showing.

12. The individual classes will be made up and divided after the cattle are checked in at the show. Any of the classes may be split if classes become too large, at the discretion of show management. They will be judged from the youngest class to the oldest class.

13. Any animal entered in the Pen Division is eligible to show in the individual classes, and vice versa. They will be required to pay an entry fee for the open show.

14. American Aberdeen Assn. offers \$6,500.00 of the premiums in the following classes and the National Western Stock Show offers \$6,500.00. Combined premiums are shown below. All premiums to be paid directly from National Western Stock Show offices.

15. Exhibitors will be required to checkin at processing table with registration papers on Tuesday, January 21 at 2:00 pm. Location will announced at a later date. Exhibitors NOT checked in WILL NOT be allowed to show.

NATIONAL WESTERN STOCK SHOW.....\$750.00

1. The National Western Stock Show will collect an entry fee of fiftyfive (\$55.00) dollars per head entered plus a ten (\$10.00) dollar administrative fee with fee and entry mailed directly to National Western Stock Show offices or enter online at nationalwestern.com. All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States funds.

2. All entries must be halter broke to lead, as they will be shown individually in the Stockyards Arena.

3. Animals competing in the Braunvieh Show must be registered in the Braunvieh Association of America (BAA) Herd Book.

4. Exhibitors must be in good standing with the Braunvieh Association of America. Exhibitors must comply with the rules and regulations of the National Western Stock Show. All animals exhibited must have a DNA sample on file with the Braunvieh Association of America. A hair or blood sample on the subject animal must be received by the BAA or BAA representative prior to the show.

5. All animals exhibited must have a known Braunvieh dam or sire and are subject to being DNA verified to its Braunvieh parent(s).

6. Animals must be Fullblood or Purebred (7/8 Braunvieh blood for females and 15/16 Braunvieh blood for males) to qualify for the FB/PB Braunvieh show. Animals with less than purebred Braunvieh blood, and 1/8 or greater Braunvieh blood, will be shown in a separate Braunvieh Beefbuilder/Percentage show. (All fractions based on breed up percentages.)

7. The BAA reserves the right to provide the judge and audience with the Expected Progeny Difference (EPDs) values, ultrasound data (collected by a certified technician), scrotal circumference for bulls, weights and ratios for performance and weights with weight per day of age. These performance figures (including weights, hip heights and frame scores) can be presented in their entirety or any combination deemed necessary by the BAA.

8. Heifers exhibited at 20 months of age or older (not females in the cow/calf class) must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy by a licensed veterinarian. For heifers used in embryo transfer, a certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must be available for inspection.

9. Females born prior to September 1, 2017 must show in the cow/calf class with a calf at side. The pair will not be eligible for champion female/heifer. Calves exhibited in the cow/calf class cannot be over 230 days of age. Calves from the cow/calf class can be entered as individuals in the show.

10. Bulls exhibited at 14 months of age or older must have a positive semen test and a certificate to that effect. The certificate must be available for inspection. Bulls 12 months and older must have a nose ring to be shown.

11. Braunvieh entries will be entered in a specific show class at time of entry.

12. No dyes, paints or other substances to alter animals natural color will be allowed. Violation will result in disqualification

13. No cosmetic surgeries other than surgical dehorning will be allowed. Violation will result in disqualification.
