NATIONAL WESTERN STOCK SHOW.....\$750.00

1. The National Western Stock Show will collect an entry fee of fiftyfive (\$55.00) dollars per head entered plus a ten (\$10.00) dollar administrative fee with fee and entry mailed directly to National Western Stock Show offices or enter online at nationalwestern.com. All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States funds.

2. All entries must be halter broke to lead, as they will be shown individually in the Stockyards Arena.

3. Animals competing in the Braunvieh Show must be registered in the Braunvieh Association of America (BAA) Herd Book.

4. Exhibitors must be in good standing with the Braunvieh Association of America. Exhibitors must comply with the rules and regulations of the National Western Stock Show. All animals exhibited must have a DNA sample on file with the Braunvieh Association of America. A hair or blood sample on the subject animal must be received by the BAA or BAA representative prior to the show.

5. All animals exhibited must have a known Braunvieh dam or sire and are subject to being DNA verified to its Braunvieh parent(s).

6. Animals must be Fullblood or Purebred (7/8 Braunvieh blood for females and 15/16 Braunvieh blood for males) to qualify for the FB/PB Braunvieh show. Animals with less than purebred Braunvieh blood, and 1/8 or greater Braunvieh blood, will be shown in a separate Braunvieh Beefbuilder/Percentage show. (All fractions based on breed up percentages.)

7. The BAA reserves the right to provide the judge and audience with the Expected Progeny Difference (EPDs) values, ultrasound data (collected by a certified technician), scrotal circumference for bulls, weights and ratios for performance and weights with weight per day of age. These performance figures (including weights, hip heights and frame scores) can be presented in their entirety or any combination deemed necessary by the BAA.

8. Heifers exhibited at 20 months of age or older (not females in the cow/calf class) must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy by a licensed veterinarian. For heifers used in embryo transfer, a certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must be available for inspection.

9. Females born prior to September 1, 2017 must show in the cow/calf class with a calf at side. The pair will not be eligible for champion female/heifer. Calves exhibited in the cow/calf class cannot be over 230 days of age. Calves from the cow/calf class can be entered as individuals in the show.

10. Bulls exhibited at 14 months of age or older must have a positive semen test and a certificate to that effect. The certificate must be available for inspection. Bulls 12 months and older must have a nose ring to be shown.

11. Braunvieh entries will be entered in a specific show class at time of entry.

12. No dyes, paints or other substances to alter animals natural color will be allowed. Violation will result in disqualification

13. No cosmetic surgeries other than surgical dehorning will be allowed. Violation will result in disqualification.

14. Only generally accepted fitting practices will be allowed. Violation will be cause for disqualification. Show committee will make ruling on a case by case basis. Animals disqualified will forfeit entry fees, awards and show points. Appeals will be forwarded to ethics committee and Executive Vice President.

15. Protests will be made to Show committee with a \$150.00 protest fee, within 24 hours of the show or prior to release, whichever is first, in writing to BAA staff or show committee member. If ruling in favor of protest, fee will be refunded. If ruling against, fee will be forfeited.

16. Appeals will be made to Show committee with a \$150.00 appeal fee. Appeal will be forwarded with all information to ethics committee and Executive Vice President. If appeal granted, fee will be returned with reinstatement of show points and any other forfeited entry fees and awards. If appeal denied, fee will be forfeited.

17. Decision of ethics committee and Executive Vice President will be final.

GROUP CLASSES

Percentage animals may be used in group classes, but may not make up the total of any one group.

- POD** **Produce of Dam:** Two (2) animals either sex from one dam, may be owned by one or more exhibitor. Both animals must be shown in their individual classes.
- GOS** **Get-of-Sire:** Three (3) animals all by one sire may be owned by more than one exhibitor. All animals must be shown in their individual classes to be eligible.
- B4H** **Breeder's Best Four Head:** Four (4) animals bred by one breeder. Not necessarily owned by the breeder or one exhibitor. Either or both sexes represented.

**BEEFBUILDER / PERCENTAGE / AMERICAN CROSS CLASSES
HIGH and LOW PERCENTAGES**

Entries in the Beefbuilder/Percentage classes and group classes will be made according to the same break down as the Fullblood/Purebred classes only using corresponding class numbers **401-413** for females and **501-513** for bulls. Beefbuilder cow/calf class number 601.

PREMIUM SCHEDULE

Premiums will be paid through 3rd place in each class. 1st place in each individual class will receive fifty (\$50) dollars and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated scale to 2nd and 3rd place after the show has been completed.

The National Western Stock Show awards ribbons to winners in each class through 5th place, rosettes to Division Champions and Reserve Division Champions and banners to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.
