**Show signs must be ordered using enclosed card.**

1. Rules and Regulations: General Rules and Regulations apply to this division as well as those rules listed below.

2. Commercial females to be judged as shown on soundness, quality, conformation and their usefulness as replacement heifers. The intent of this show is for commercial oriented heifers.

3. Entries must be mailed to the National Western Stock Show Office or enter online at [nationalwestern.com](http://nationalwestern.com)

4. All entries must be in their assigned pens no later than the date and time specified in the Arrival and Release Schedule.

5. Exhibitor is allowed one (1) alternate heifer per load and may sell with load. Females entered in this division cannot be entered in any other division of the show.

6. For each entry consignors must present a health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian stating that the heifers are open or bred. Certificate must be issued within fourteen (14) days prior to the show and sale. Heifers will be pregnancy checked at the sellers expense. Seller represents heifers as they are for current and future breeding purposes. All guarantees are between the seller and buyer. All health certificates must be turned in upon arrival and must state that the animals have or have not been implanted and/or vaccinated. Four (4) copies of each are required. All heifer calves must be officially calfhood vaccinated for brucellosis (official vaccination tags must be intact), show a negative BVD-PI test and treated for scabies, with proof of such submitted with health certificate. (Refer to Health Requirements in front of Livestock Premium List) **CONSIGNORS MUST SUBMIT INFORMATION ON THE PROVIDED FORM AND SUBMIT IT WITH THE ENTRY FORM FOR THE SALE CATALOG PREPARATION.**

7. Females will be judged, (removal of manure, mud or bedding acceptable). Torching or singeing of heifers will be accepted. A champion and reserve will be picked in each division. A overall champion will be selected.

8. All Commercial Females will be weighed prior to show.

9. Commercial Females will be sold in order of placings on Wednesday, January 22<sup>nd</sup> Commission of seven (7%) percent of gross sales will be charged. Refer to Rules and Regulations item listed as National Western Stock Show Livestock Sales. Any purchase not announced in the Auction Ring as a "No Sale" must be paid for by check by the consignor.

#### **10. Premiums:**

Some premium money and ribbons will be offered by the National Western Stock Show.

**MODERATOR DIVISION OF COMMERCIAL FEMALES**

This division is for moderate framed females in the Commercial Female Show and Sale. This division will be named the Moderator division. These cattle will be no larger than a frame score 5.5. These entries can be of any breed or combination of breeds including crosses of conventional cattle with Lowlines, Miniature Herefords or other breeds.

**Rules:** In addition to the rules listed above the following will pertain to the Moderator Division;

1. All females will be measured for frame score and each entry in a pen must be no larger than a 5.5 frame score. All females will be measured at the hip and all decisions regarding frame score size will be determined by the National Western staff. If an entered pen does not have 10 females to compete in the Moderator division they be given the opportunity to show in the conventional division

**SPECIAL AWARDS:**

Colorado Angus Association would like to offer the following premiums for the 2020 NWSS Commercial Female show and sale held in the yards:

In each division, bred and heifer calves, the Colorado Angus Association would offer a cash premium of \$250.00 for Grand Champion and \$150.00 for the Reserve Grand Champion, with the following qualifications to be met:

1. Exhibitor must be a current paid member of the Colorado Angus Association at time of entry deadline with the NWSS.
2. Cattle must be of Angus influence and exhibit Angus characteristics. (i.e. black, polled, or black baldies/brockle face.)
3. Where possible, exhibitor is encouraged to submit pedigree information when possible in regards to (Angus) registration numbers of sires/dams, , and/or sires that females are bred or exposed to.
4. Exhibitor would consent to allow Association use of winning results for promotion and advertising.

**The Colorado Angus Association has final authority as to who and if a premium will be paid.**
