

JUNIOR REGISTERED EWE LAMBS/YEARLING EWES

ENTRIES CLOSE DECEMBER 20, 2019

Junior ewe lambs will be shown January 25 and January 26, prior to the Open show breeding shows.

1. General Rules and Regulations and Junior Livestock Show Rules and Regulations found in the front of this Livestock Premium Book apply to this division as well as those rules listed in each specific division. All Participants must read and abide by these rules.

2. Ewe lambs must be registered in the flock book of their respective breed and bear the ear tags of the association before entering the show ring. Ewe lambs must be registered in the individual exhibitor's, sibling or family ownership name prior to November 1, 2019. Wether Sire/Dam ewe lambs and yearlings are eligible for the junior show and showmanship as registration papers are not required. An ownership certificate is required for all Wether Sire/Dam sheep by November 1, 2019.

3. Only ewe lambs born on or after January 1, 2019 may be shown and must have all lamb teeth intact.

4. Classes offered for Hampshire, Suffolk and Southdown breeds and any other breed with at least ten (10) entries minimum. Classes may be combined if deemed necessary by Stock Show.

5. A single participant may enter not more than two (2) ewe lambs in each breed.

6. A junior ewe lamb may also be entered in the open show if the additional entry fee is paid and the entry postmarked on or before December 20, 2019.

7. At the discretion of the superintendent, classes with more than twenty (20) animals entered may be divided by age into two (2) classes of approximately equal numbers. Premiums will be paid in each class.

8. All animals must meet Livestock Health Requirements.

9. Lambs must be shown without coat compounds, including oils, paints, powders, and other dressing. Violation will result in automatic disqualification, with no recourse.

10. Substitutions within the same class (60 day age classification for those not classified in the Premium Book) and same owner only will be accepted. There will be no substitution of animals in different classes (60 day age classification). Only one (1) substitution for original animal will be allowed. Substitutions must be in writing on an official National Western Stock Show substitution form no later than 48 hours prior to show. No substitutions will be allowed after that date.
