SPECIAL RULES

1. General Rules and Regulations, Junior Livestock Show Rules and Regulations, and Auction of Junior Livestock Champions Rules and Regulations found in the Livestock Premium List apply to this division as well as the following special rules. All Participants must read and abide by these rules.
2. Entries must be made on official 2020 National Western Stock Show entry forms. **New Ownership Requirements: All entries must be owned by the Participant as of November 1, 2019.**
3. Animals entered in this division may be either wether kids or does. Doe(s) that have exhibited in the wether doe show are not eligible to exhibit in the market goat show.
4. **Participants are permitted to enter up to ten (10) market goats and allowed to bring and show no more than four (4) market goats. You must pay for all ten (10).**
5. Each entry must contain the signature of the County Agent or FFA Advisor. Absolutely NO late entries. The Primary Care Form must accompany your entry.
6. Market Goats must be slick shorn, with no indication of blocking, to 3/8 inch or less above the knees and hock joints to include the head but excluding the tail switch. **All shearing of Market Goats must be done only in a designated area (show ring) prior to processing. No trim tables can be used after that time, but cordless clipper will be allowed.**
7. Wethers having one (1) or both testicles contained in body cavity are ineligible to Show and will be condemned at slaughter.
8. **Official Weight.** The weight recorded at time of processing will become the official weight and cannot be changed. A weight card obtained from the superintendents office, must be filled out by all Junior Market exhibitors and turned in at processing with a called/declared weight. This will become the official weight. All junior market goats will be divided into classes according to this weight. No reweighs will be allowed once the animal has stepped off the scale. Minimum weight for market goats is sixty (60) pounds; maximum weight of one hundred twentyfive (125) pounds. A 5% weigh back will be allowed and the top 4-5 in each class are eligible for a weigh back.
9. Water. A container, with water, must be present in each pen at all times.
10. Bedding. Straw is not allowed for bedding in the goat barn. Carpet or rubber mats may be used for bedding. Shavings and bedding must be purchased through the National Western Feed Concession. First bedding will not be provided for any animals. Carpet will be allowed but must be water permeable. **Shavings will be allowed under carpet only.**
11. Goats that potentially may be eligible for the Auction of Junior Livestock Champions may be reweighed. If there is a variance of more than **five percent (5%)** from the official weight, the goat will be disqualified. Processing weight will be official for sale weight.
12. **GOATS FRONT FEET MUST BE ON THE FLOOR WHILE SHOWING. THE FRONT FEET CAN BE PICKED UP TO SET THE ANIMAL AND THEN PLACED BACK DOWN ON THE FLOOR.**
13. Goats are to be broke to lead.
14. Market Goats cannot use oils, paints, powders, glitters or other dressings at all while grounds, from arrival to the NWSS grounds to the time they are put on the truck. Clear adhesive glue will be allowed on legs only.
15. No substitutions will be allowed.
16. Horns. If horned, Market Goats must have horns tipped (not less than the diameter of a dime at the end). Tipping of horns is not allowed on the grounds.

17. **Drenching will be allowed with drench guns, but the use of stomach pumps are prohibited.** Violation of this rule will result in disqualification with no recourse and be subject to other sanctions. .
18. **Participants may use collars or collars with a short lead when showing. No extreme collars (spike/training) or halters will be allowed in the show ring.**
18. **Exhibitors may use meshed or plastic muzzles on lambs and goats at the NWSS. the style used must allow the animal to drink water.**
20. Pen Assignments: National Western Stock Show management can assign pens or stalls to any exhibitor at its discretion in all species. Two (2) goats to a pen. No tack stalls will be allowed.
21.
 - a. Goats may not be given injections or have any foreign objects, including but not limited to needles, placed in their bodies except that subcutaneous injections of approved medications may be given in front of the point of the shoulder, i.e., in the goat's neck. Injections must be given in conformity with the American Sheep Industry Association's "Sheep Safety and Quality Assurance Program (© September 2004)". **Note Rule 8.c. of the Junior Livestock Show Rules and Regulations concerning information that must be provided for each animal.**
 - b. Any exception to this rule must be requested in writing, accompanied by a statement from a licensed veterinarian setting forth the date, injectable, purpose of the injection and reason why it could not be injected in the goat's neck. Any such written request may be granted or denied in the sole discretion of the Stock Show.
22. The Auction of Junior Livestock Champions will be held Friday, January 24, 2020.
