1. Rules and Regulations: General Rules and Regulations apply to this division as well as those rules listed below and in specific breed divisions, ie: Angus, Charolais, Salers, etc.

2. Breeding Cattle: Judges are instructed to award prizes for breeding cattle in the different classes and in the order in which they, as buyers, would make selection for breeding purposes. The primary objective of the show is to encourage the breeding and feeding of improved breeds and types of livestock for well-defined practical purposes. In groups, encouragement will be given to uniformity of breed type.

3. Bulls: A bull over one year of age without a ring in his nose will be excluded from exhibition at the discretion of Stock Show and in the interest of safety to spectators.

4. Breed Association Sales: All animals entered in the "Hill" sales must be entered in Stock Show classes and with their National Breed Association.

5. Breed Registration: Any animal entered in the Carload and/or Pen Divisions in the "Yards" is not eligible to show in individual classes on the "Hill" and vice versa, unless specified otherwise within specific Livestock Breed Divisions.

6. Paint: No paint/coloring agents may be used in the make-up areas or show arenas.

7. Canadian Cattle Requirements: Cattle originating from Canada coming to the National Western Stock Show for show only, are required to have a legible ear tattoo. Those animals to be sold or that will stay in the U.S. are required to have a CAN brand and legible tattoo. (See Health Requirements and Brand Inspection sections in front of the Premium Book for details.)

8. Yards Other Breeds: Any Yards Other Breeds (Aberdeen, Braunvieh, Dexter, Galloway, Longhorn, Piedmontese, Wagyu) that show less than 25 head will be placed on one (1) year probation and National Western will select the judge. After a probationary year, if numbers shown are not above 25, they will become a demonstration breed until numbers come back up above 25.
