

# LIMOUSIN CARLOAD SHOW

Animals competing in the Limousin carload show must be registered and 75% Limousin or higher as computed by NALF or a registered Lim-Flex. Additionally, there are no restrictions on the number of 75% or above Limousin or Lim-Flex bulls allowed in a carload. Bulls entered in a carload show are not eligible for the pen show or for the open show on the Hill. Alternates for the carload show must fit in the same class as the rest of the carload. Limousin and Lim-Flex carload animals must be out of the cows that are in the exhibitor's membership or exhibitor's family membership(s). Animals out of leased cows are not permitted in the carload show.

Classes for Limousin carloads will be determined by the oldest bull in the carload and according to the following ranges in birth dates.

- 112. Carload of 8 Yearling Bulls  
(calved January 1 - April 30, 2018)
- 113. Carload of 8 Yearling Bulls  
(calved May 1 - August 31, 2018)
- 114. Carload of 8 Yearling Bulls  
(calved September 1 - December 31, 2018)
- 115. Carload of 10 Calves  
(calved January 1 - February 14, 2019)
- 116. Carload of 10 Calves  
(calved February 15 - March 31, 2019)
- 117. Carload of 10 Calves  
(calved April 1 - May 31, 2019)

## PREMIUMS

Each exhibitor in this show will pay a fee of one hundred twenty dollars (\$120) per carload entered. Entries are to be mailed to the National Western Stock Show or enter online at [www.nationalwestern.com](http://www.nationalwestern.com). All fees must be paid in U.S. funds.

All premiums will be determined at the discretion of NALF staff and mailed directly from the National Western Stock Show offices.

# PEN SHOW

## RECEPTION OF LIVESTOCK

No animals will be allowed in the "Yards" or on "The Hill" either in tie outs or in the barns/pens prior to January 2. Due to our new extended livestock schedule, all livestock must comply with the Arrival and Release schedule for both the "Yards" and the "Hill". Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

### SIGNS MUST BE ORDERED USING ENCLOSED ORDER FORM.

1. Rules and Regulations: General Rules and Regulations apply to this division as well as those rules listed below and in specific breed divisions, ie: Angus, Charolais, etc.

2. All entries close **November 20, 2019** and should be made through the **National Western Stock Show** or online at [www.nationalwestern.com](http://www.nationalwestern.com). Late entries will be accepted after the postmarked entry deadline up to December 10, 2019 by paying an entry fee fifty (50%) percent greater than those listed in each division. No entries will be accepted after December 10, 2019.

3. Animals must be entered and shown by the original breeder or first owner. Animals entered and exhibited in this division must be owned by an individual, corporation, partnership, and/or working family unit. Animals, or interest in animals sold by the original breeder or first owner may be entered and shown by the original breeder or first owner after transfer of ownership. Animals purchased as embryos, flushes or pregnancies may be shown by purchaser as first owner.

4. Animals exhibited in the Pen classes may be shown in any other division of the show. Animals exhibited in the individual classes or Carloads are eligible to be shown in the Pen division and vice versa.

5. **The assignment of pens will be made at the time entry fees are completely paid and only to animals that arrive at the show. Entry fees do not dictate pen space. Specific pen requests must be submitted in writing and in the Yards Office by December 10, 2019. There is no guarantee the requests can or will be honored. Night pen and tie out space will be assigned separately from the exhibit pens. Pens on or near the Main Alley will not be used as Night Pens.**

6. Three (3) bulls or three (3) females per exhibitor from the Pen divisions in the Yards may sell in the official breed association sale with the exception of those breeds which specify otherwise, provided they are selected in time to be catalogued for the sale by the breed association except for the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Pen. In addition, uncataloged bulls or females from the Pen division champion will be allowed to enter the sale not to exceed five (5) head from any breed. The breed association accepts full responsibility and liability of the transfer of the animal. The bulls or females are to be returned to their respective pens in the Yards immediately following the sale to remain on display until release time.

7. All alternate bulls must be designated and processed on the day of check-in with the breed association.

8. Only those animals within the specific ages for the listed classes will be eligible to show (unless otherwise specified by breed association).

9. **All animals in the Yards during the National Western Stock Show, including Hill cattle, sold or unsold, will be charged a yardage fee of sixty (\$60) dollars per head and a nonrefundable administrative fee of ten (\$10) dollars per head. Yardage fee and administrative fee must be paid at time of original entry. This also includes all sale cattle not entered in the show!**

10. In case animals are ruled out of competition, the pens may be allotted to other show exhibitors.

11. All cattle entered in the Pen division must be in their assigned pens on the date and time shown on "Yard" Arrival and Release Date schedule, otherwise pens will be reassigned. If Stock Show is notified, in writing, by January 1, 2020, that the exhibitor is cancelling their entry and releases the pen at that time, the yardage fee will be refunded after the show.
