1. Each exhibitor in this show will pay a fee of fifty-five dollars (\$55.00) per head entered. From this fee, forty dollars (\$40.00) must be mailed to the National Western Stock Show or enter online at [www.nationalwestern.com](http://www.nationalwestern.com) as a standard entry fee for breeding cattle and fifteen dollars (\$15.00) must be mailed (along with a copy of the entry form) to the North American South Devon Association, Attn: Sherry Doubet, 19590 East Main Street, #104, Parker, CO 80138 as a show fee. All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States funds.

2. Classes are open to 3/4 blood, 7/8 blood, Purebred, and Fullblood females; and to 7/8 blood, Purebred and Fullblood bulls. The animals must be registered with the NASDA. Registration certificates must be presented at time of check-in at National Western Stock Show. EPD's will be provided in the show program and also to the judges for consideration in placing classes.

3. Original registration certificates must be presented to NASDA show officials at the time of tattoo inspection. All animals must have a clear, legible tattoo that includes the herd prefix and the year letter designation. The tattoo must correspond to the registration certificate or the animal will be disqualified.

4. All females born prior to April 30, 2018 must be accompanied by a veterinarian's statement of pregnancy within thirty (30) days of the show or a statement that the animal has already calved or that fertilized eggs have been recovered by an ova transplant facility.

5. Cattle are to be shown in their natural conformation. The use of false tailheads other use of color altering adhesives or paint and or adding hair or other materials to any part of the animal's body is prohibited.

There will be five thousand two hundred (\$5,200) dollars in prize funds offered. The NASDA offers two thousand six hundred (\$2,600) dollars of the premiums and the National Western Stock Show offers two thousand six hundred (\$2,600) dollars of the premiums. All checks will be mailed directly from the National Western Stock Show offices.

**GROUP CLASSES**

Only one Poundmaker per class, except for Get-of-Sire and the Best Five Head two Pound,makers are allowed.

<b>POB Two Bulls</b> - Bred and owned by exhibitor. Must be shown in individual classes (201 to 212) to be eligible.....	B
<b>POC Pair of Calves</b> - Two (2) calves, both sexes to be represented. Bred and owned by exhibitor. Must be shown in individual classes (101 to 106 and 201 to 206) to be eligible and must also be shown in individual classes .....	B
<b>POY Pair of Yearlings</b> - Two (2) yearlings, both sexes to be represented. Bred and owned by exhibitor. Must be shown in individual classes (107 to 110 and 207 to 210) to be eligible and must also be shown in individual classes .....	B
<b>POD Produce of Dam</b> - Two (2) animals, either sex, from one (1) dam. May be owned by more than one (1) exhibitor. Must be shown in individual classes to be eligible.....	B
<b>JOS Junior Get-of-Sire</b> - Three (3) calves, calved after September 1, 2016. All by one (1) sire, both sexes to be represented. May be owned by more than one (1) exhibitor. All animals must be shown in individual classes to be eligible.....	B
<b>GOS Get-Of-Sire</b> - Four (4) animals, all by one (1) sire, both sexes to be represented. May be owned by more than one (1) exhibitor. This Get must have a minimum of two (2) animals born before September 1, 2017. All animals must be shown in individual classes to be eligible.....	B

**B5H Group of Five** - Five (5) Head, both sexes represented, owned in part or all by the exhibitor, including immediate family ownership such as children or grandchildren, and shown in any of the individual classes to be eligible and shown in any of the individual classes to be eligible.....B

**Premier Exhibitor:** Points will be awarded to the person entering and exhibiting the animal including immediate family ownership such as children or grandchildren, with the winner being determined by the individual animal’s placement within individual classes with the maximum number of placements being limited to five (5). Points allowed are three (3) for 1st in class, two (2) for 2nd in class and one (1) for 3rd in class. In addition, three (3) points will be awarded for Grand Champions and two (2) points for Reserve Grand Champions. No points are awarded for division champions or reserves. In case of a tie, additional placements beyond five (5) will be used until a winner is determined. Multiple ownerships will be considered as a separate entry of their own.

**Premier Breeder:** Exhibitors in contention are the registered breeders of record or immediate family members with the same prefix, this includes children or grandchildren, with the winner being determined by the individual animal’s placement within individual classes, and the maximum number of placements being limited to five (5). Points allowed are three (3) for 1st in class, two (2) for 2nd in class and one (1) for 3rd in class. In addition, three (3) points will be awarded for Grand Champions and two (2) points for Reserve Grand Champions. No points will be allowed for division champions or reserves. In case of a tie, additional placements beyond five (5) will be used until a winner is determined. Multiple breeders will be considered as a separate entry of their own.

**POUNDMAKER SHOW:**

To qualify to show in the percentage South Devon Show, the females need to be 25% - 74.9% South Devon and the bulls 25%-87.4% South Devon. The age classification would be the same as the purebred show. The same entry rules and premiums would apply for the poundmaker show that now apply for the open show and would run concurrently with the open show.

**601. Cow-Calf Pairs** - Cows that are exhibited with calves at side must be lactating. Calves must be nursing on day of judging. Calves may not be older than 285 days on day of show. Calf entries in the cow-calf class may be shown individually providing individual entry has been made. Cows may be evaluated and screened out of the show on the basis of udder quality. Lowest breed percentage of the cow or calf will determine which show the pair show in. The determination of the Show Committee will be final ..... A
