1. **Entries:** All NWSS livestock entries are online at [livestockentry.nationalwestern.com](http://livestockentry.nationalwestern.com).
  - A. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.
  - B. Animals must be entered and shown by the original breeder or first owners.
  - C. Entry deadline is November 20, 2021. Late entries are accepted with additional fees until December 10, 2021.
2. **Special Rules:**
  - A. Exhibitors who participate in shows that accept premium monies contributed by the American Angus Association are subject to the Association rules as found in the Breeders' Reference Guide of the Association. The rules relating directly with the exhibition of Angus Cattle are Part 2; Association Rules, Rules 800 Series; including Rule 800-810. These rules can be found at [www.angus.org](http://www.angus.org).
  - B. **Processing and Alternates:** All carloads and pens of bulls will be weighed prior to entering the ring and average weights will be calculated. Exhibitors must designate alternate bulls at check-in to the American Angus Association Pen and Carload Superintendent. If an alternate is to be used following check-in, it can only be done in the case of death, unsoundness or sickness. This must be approved by the Association Superintendent. The decision of the Superintendent will be final. Bulls must be loose when exhibited.
  - C. Classes will be broken after arrival and processing according to the average age in days. Class designation is calculated on the average age of the bulls in the carload. Bulls may be no more than 30 days older or younger than the age classification specified for the class.
  - D. **Premiums:** First place in each individual class will receive \$750 and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis among the other entries exhibited after the show has been completed. Total premium money is \$3,600, 50% paid by the American Angus Association and 50% paid by National Western Stock Show. All premium checks will be mailed directly from the National Western Stock Show offices.
