### 1. Entries:

A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at [livestockentry.nationalwestern.com](http://livestockentry.nationalwestern.com).

### 2. Health Regs:

A. **Health certs are not required, birds will be inspected by vets upon arrival to NWSS.**

B. Any animal showing symptoms of disease, parasites, broken wings or beaks will not be admitted. Birds shown need to be fully feathered, no bald spots

C. If animals are neglected, abused, mishandled, not fed, or pens not cleaned, the superintendent will ask the member to remove their animal from the grounds and forfeit all premiums. This exhibitor may be ineligible for future National Western events as determined by the Rule Enforcement Committee.

### 3. Age and Entry Limits:

A. Exhibitor will not be present during judging of birds. Judge will answer questions following judging.

B. Poultry showmanship takes place January 22 at 10:00 a.m. There will be Pee-Wee, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior awards. Pee-Wee: under 8, Junior: 8-10 years, Intermediate: 11-13 years, Seniors: 14 years and over.

C. Meat Pen Chickens (Pen of 3); must all be same sex, Minimum of 5 weeks old, but no older than 7 months. Each bird must weigh a Minimum of 4lbs and a maximum of 11lbs. There can be no more than a ½ lb. weight difference

D. No exhibitor may have more than two entries in the Meat Production Pen of 3 class. Pen class is a Junior show only ages 5-18 as of January 1, 2022.

E. Ribbons to be awarded through 10th place and premiums to be paid to the “Best of Breeds” (with 8 or more in a breed), Grand and Reserve Grand Champions.

F. Exhibitors will receive their ribbons upon release.

G. Exhibitor is responsible for furnishing padlock, if desired (recommended for pigeons and game birds.) If cages are locked, exhibitor is responsible for unlocking cage during judging. Locked entries will not be judged. Exhibitors may wish to furnish appropriate sized cages for pigeons and game birds.
