

# NATIONAL ROE CHAROLAIS PEN SHOW

## BULLS AND HEIFERS

ENTRIES DUE ONLINE NOVEMBER 20, 2022 Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at [livestockentry.nationalwestern.com](http://livestockentry.nationalwestern.com).
  - B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$55.00 per Pen of Three and \$65.00 per Pen of Five. Yardage fees are \$70.00 per head entered. **Free power and parking are included with entry.**
  - C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store online at [store.nationalwestern.com](http://store.nationalwestern.com) or on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
  - D. AICA registration numbers must be stated on entries.
  - E. Entry deadline is November 20, 2022. Late entries are accepted with additional fees until December 10, 2022.
1. Special Rules:
- A. Bulls and Heifers competing in this division must be purebred and registered with the American International Charolais Association (AICA). A bull(s) is eligible for entry if registered in country of origin outside the United States and is eligible for purebred registry in the AICA Herdbook. Bulls and Heifers registered in the AICA Colored Division Registry (QM initialed registration numbers) must meet the perimeters of the AICA Color-Card.
  - B. Bulls calved before January 1, 2022, must have a valid satisfactory semen test. Bulls must have a legible tattoo or firebrand. All other rules of AICA and NWSS apply.
  - C. One alternate bull or heifer may be brought, but the pen entry must be specified to AICA staff at the conclusion of processing.
  - D. Effective October 22, 2004 at any American International Charolais Association (AICA) sanctioned show (including shows receiving AICA premium funding and/or qualifying as a Roll of Excellence Show), the use of a coloring agent, flock and powder is prohibited, Use of these products will result in the immediate disqualification of a given animal at such show.
  - E. AICA will contribute \$2,250 in premiums for the Pen of Five and Three Show to be paid directly from the NWSS office.
  - F. Bull Premiums: First place in each individual class will receive \$250 and premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis among the other entries through 3rd place after the show has been completed. Premium checks will be paid directly from the National Western Stock Show office.
  - G. Heifer Premiums: AICA will contribute up to \$500 in premiums for the heifer pen show and NWSS will contribute up to \$500 in premiums for the show. First place in each individual class will receive \$150 and premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis after the show has been completed. Premium checks will be paid directly from National Western Stock Show offices.

**CHAROLAIS PEN BULLS**

- 101 Pen of Five Bulls (calved after January 1, 2022)
- 102 Pen of Five Bulls (calved September 1 - December 31, 2021)
- CHAMPION PEN OF FIVE BULLS ..... Banner
- RESERVE CHAMPION PEN OF FIVE BULLS ..... Banner
  - The oldest bull in an entry after processing for classes 133 and 134 determines the class in which that entry is shown.
- 201 Pen of Three Bulls .....(calved after January 1, 2022)
- 202 Pen of Three Bulls .....(calved September 1 - December 31, 2021)
- 203 Pen of Three Bulls ..... (calved January 1 - August 31, 2021)
- CHAMPION PEN OF THREE BULLS ..... Banner
- RESERVE CHAMPION PEN OF THREE BULLS ..... Banner
  - Entries for class 135 will be broken after processing into classes based on average age in days of declared bulls making up pen entries. For classes 136 and 137 and/or an entry with a bull calved before January 1, 2021, the oldest bull in an entry after processing will determine the class in which an entry shows.

- 301 Heifers born January 1, 2022 and after
  - 302 Heifers born September 1 - December 31, 2021
  - CHAMPION PEN OF HEIFERS ..... Banner
  - RESERVE CHAMPION PEN OF HEIFERS ..... Banner
- If circumstances exist and/or allow, AICA reserves the right to split individual classes after the check-in procedure is complete.*
