1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at livestockentry.nationalwestern.com.
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$25.00 per head, and \$5.00/group class. Free parking included with entry.
- C. Substitutions within the same class (60 day age classification for those not classified in the Premium Book) will be allowed no later than January 21, 2023. There will be no substitution of animals in different classes (60 day age classification). Only one (1) substitution for original animal will be allowed. No exceptions. Absolutely no refunds or credits will be allowed.
- D. **No entries or substitutions accepted at the gate.**
- E. All entries must meet health requirements (see Health Regulations).

2. Special Rules:

- A. General Rules and Regulations apply to this division as well as those rules listed below.
- B. Association specials are controlled by the Associations. No more than two (2) premiums may be awarded any Participant in the individual classes. One (1) premium will be awarded a Participant per group class.
- C. All sheep in purebred classes must be registered in flock books of their respective breeds and bear the ear tags of the Association (where applicable) before entering the ring. Registration certificates or copies of them must be forwarded with entries or entries will not be accepted.
- D. The Wether Sire and Dam Class will consist of non-registered and crossbred sheep. Classes for Ewes and Rams, Junior and Open Divisions, will be shown slick shorn. All sheep exhibited in the Meat Breed Divisions (except Southdown) must be fitted and not slick shorn. Those slick shorn sheep may enter the Wether Sire/ Dam Division In all other breed classes, Junior and Open, "registration papers" are required. These sheep are eligible for junior showmanship, junior ewe lamb and junior yearling. Sheep entered in the Pure Breed Divisions cannot enter the same sheep in the Wether Sire/Dam Division.
- E. Sheep entered in lamb classes must have all lamb teeth in place. Those entered in yearling classes may have two (2) or four (4) permanent teeth.
- F. Where the animals of only one (1) participant or his/her immediate family are shown, the judge will award only one (1) prize, which may be the grade to which the judge feels that the exhibit is entitled, and need not necessarily be a first (1st) or second (2nd) prize.
- G. All breeding sheep must be owned by the participant, individual, or immediate family on or before December 20, 2022. On sheep transferred, the date of transfer officially recorded by the breed

association shall be date of ownership. Base date for age determination for all breeds of sheep is January 1, with the exception of Dorset Breed, whose base date of age determination is November 1.

- H. At least five (5) head per class must be entered before a class will be held, otherwise classes may be combined. The decision of the Superintendent shall be final in regard to the classifications of entries in this department.
- I. At the discretion of the Superintendent, classes with more than twenty (20) animals entered may be divided by age into two (2) classes of approximately equal numbers. Premiums will be paid in each class, however, if original class is divided, premiums will also be divided.
- J. Each exhibitor that enters sheep in the Purebred Wool Breed Classes may enter and show one ewe and one ram (lamb or yearling) in the White Handspinning Division.
- K. Only two (2) entries per exhibitor/family will be counted toward total entries in a class. Only two (2) entries per exhibitor/family will be counted toward total entries in a class.
- L. A group is considered two (2) or more animals owned by exhibitor/family. Entry fee is required.
- M. Flock and group class(s) are Family Classes. Entry may be comprised of animals owned by more than one (1) member within exhibitor's family.

1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at livestockentry.nationalwestern.com.
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$25.00 per head, and \$5.00/group class. Free parking included with entry.
- C. Substitutions within the same class (60 day age classification for those not classified in the Premium Book) will be allowed no later than January 21, 2023. Substitution must be requested on an official National Western Substitution. Registration papers must be presented with the substitution. There will be no substitution of animals in different classes (60 day age classification). Only one (1) substitution for original animal will be allowed. No exceptions. Absolutely no refunds or credits will be allowed on any substitution. **No entries or substitutions accepted at the gate.**
- D. All entries must meet health requirements (see Health Regulations).
- E. No entries will be accepted at the gate.
- F. Only two (2) entries per individual family will be counted toward total entries in a class.
- G. Each exhibitor that enters sheep in the Purebred Wool Breed Classes may enter and show one ewe and one ram (lamb or yearling) in the White Handspinning Division.

2. Special Rules:

- A. This division will be divided into two (2) categories based on foundation or origin of color in the sheep and (2) categories in White Handspinning Sheep.
- B. Category I Long Wools/Carpet: Wool grading 48's and coarser, sheep that are descendants of Lincoln, Romney, Border Leicester, Jacob, Karakul, Navajo and Churro.
- C. Category II Medium and Fine Wool: All sheep descendants of dual purpose meat breeds, (i.e. Corriedale, Columbia, Rambouillet, Hampshire or any other breed with wool grading 50's or finer). Sheep showing hair or modulated fiber will be discriminated against in this category.
- D. Animal Preparation: For Category I sheep, wool length is expected to be two (2) inches or longer, except in young lambs. Sheep may be trimmed, tipped, or fuzzed-off, but not blocked. Bellies, heads, lower legs, and dock area may have wool of any length preferred by Participant, but wool must not be trimmed or blocked to unequal lengths on chest, back, shoulder, sides, or britch area. Wool must be free of excessive contamination, manure, paint, permanent stains, wool rot, breaks or tenderness, and coting. These problems will be penalized according to their severity. Category II sheep (which includes Fine and Medium Breeds) may be fitted to breeder preference while maintaining the quality of the fleece to be evaluated.

- E. All sheep will be judged 40% on conformation and 60% on wool. All Natural Colored sheep must be 35% colored.
- F. All sheep must be shorn after January 1, 2022.
- G. December 1 shall be used for computing age.
