- <u>The Parade will not be used as a platform or promotion for any special interests and</u> <u>should promote and align with Western Stock Show Association purposes. The Parade</u> <u>Committee reserves the right to determine if entry applications are in the best interest</u> <u>of Western Stock Show Association.</u> Any parade-day deviations from the originally accepted application, violations of the stated guidelines or inappropriate behavior could result in your unit's exclusion from the parade.

3. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:


i. Before an applicant can be accepted for entry in the parade, the following insurance requirements must be provided to The Western Stock Show Association.

 For all non-individual participants, a Certificate of Insurance verifying Commercial General Liability Insurance (at least \$1,000,000 limit), Workers Compensation, and Auto Liability (if a vehicle is involved-at least \$1,000,000 limit). General and Auto Liability must name The Western Stock Show Association and the City and County of Denver as additional insured. A Waiver of Subrogation must be provided as respects Workers Compensation.
For all individual participants, a Certificate of Insurance verifying Homeowners or Farm Owners liability, with limits of at least \$300,000. If a vehicle is involved, verification of Auto Liability must be provided, with a limit of at least \$300,000.

- 4. Under Colorado law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. Pursuant to Section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes.
- 5. Throwing of anything from any entry will not be permitted along the parade route. Violations could result in the immediate removal of the unit from the parade. This prohibition includes handing of items from horseback or squirting fluids into the crowd.
- 6. NO beer or alcoholic beverages of any kind will be allowed prior to or during the parade.
- 7. Drones are not permitted prior to or during the parade.
- 8. Once approved payment will be required and all forms completed and submitted within 10 business days.

The Western Stock Show Association - Parade Insurance Requirements

INSURANCE CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

All Insurance companies must be approved to do business in the State of Colorado and acceptable to WSSA. WSSA its Directors, Officers, employees, agents and the City and County of Denver, must be added as additional insured on the General and Auto Liability policies with a 30-day written notice for any changes in coverage or cancellation of the policies. Certificates must be in the office of WSSA 30 days prior to the effective date of this agreement or forfeit all rights under this agreement.

The Contractor understands that as an independent contractor, he or she or his or her employees, are not covered by WSSA General Liability Insurance and/or Worker's Compensation Insurance.

HOLD HARMLESS INDEMNITY

The Contractor further warrants that all copyright materials, to be performed or used during the term of this agreement, have been duly licensed or authorized by their copyright owners or agents and **Contractor** agrees to be responsible for all license and royalty fees incurred by reason of any performance or use of copyright materials and in addition to any provisions contained elsewhere in this agreement to indemnify and hold the WSSA harmless from any and all losses and expenses incurred with regard thereto. The Contractor will not be obligated to indemnify, defend or hold WSSA from any claim or demand which arises solely out of negligent act or failure to act by WSSA, its officers or employees.

AUTO LIABILITY

Commercial Automobile liability insurance, covering all owned autos or any vehicles to be used during WSSA events, including Non-Owned and Hired Auto, with coverage, having, with a minimum liability limit of \$1,000,000.00 per any one occurrence. WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE
