1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are on line at livestockentry.nationalwestern.com.
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$35.00 per head. Free parking included with entry.
- C. Heifers are eligible to show in the Open show as well. Entry must be made for both shows.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.

2. Special Rules:

- A. All rules for the American Aberdeen Open Show apply to this division. Females in this division must be registered in the American Aberdeen Registry. Heifers must be registered in the sole name of the exhibitor by November 1, 2023.
- B. Junior show exhibitors wishing to enter the Open Show may do so through NWSS on line entries. Classes shall be split as near to equal numbers as possible by show superintendents. The National Western Stock Show will pay \$500.00 in premiums. All premiums will be paid directly from the National Western Stock Show offices.
