PREMIUMS - PROVIDED BY NATIONAL WESTERN STOCK SHOW

1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at livestockentry.nationalwestern.com.
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$65.00 per head, and a \$25.00 per head pre-bedding fee will be added.
Free power and parking are included with entry.
- C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store online at store.nationalwestern.com or on grounds during the Feed Office hours (7AM-7PM) should they choose to do so.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.

2. Special Rules:

- A. All animals entered in the National Aberdeen Show must be registered with the American Aberdeen Association. Exhibitors must have proof of registration at the time of check in at National Western Stock Show. There will be a Fullblood show and a Percentage/Purebred (1/2, 3/4, 7/8, etc.) show. Group classes can contain both Percentage or Purebred and Fullblood cattle in the same group and will all compete against each other.
- B. Cattle must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership at the time of the show entry deadline. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in the individual classes.
- C. All animals must be properly tattooed and will be inspected at the show. Tattoo must be legible and must match registration papers.
- D. All bulls born before September 1, 2022 must show with a nose-lead. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the show committee.
- E. Any female with a calf at side, regardless of age, must show in the Cow-Calf class. All females born before August 31, 2021 must be shown with calf at side. All females 20 months of age at the time of the show must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of safe in calf will apply to: 1.) a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian or 2.) females shown with calf at side.
- F. All females shown in the cow/calf classes with a calf over 150 days must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the safe in calf rule will apply to a donor female that has produced eggs in the previous twelve

(12) months as verified by a written statement from a licensed veterinarian.

- G. Cow-Calf classes – Any female with a calf at side, regardless of age, must show in the Cow-Calf class. Calf must be cow’s natural calf. Cows that are exhibited with calves at the side must be lactating to calves born on or after May 1, 2022 and must be nursing. Calf entries in the Cow-Calf class may be shown individually providing individual entry has been made. Cows may be evaluated and screened out of the show on the basis of udder quality. The determination of the show committee will be final.
- H. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation, or not abiding by the show rules, will be disqualified and denied the privilege of showing.
- I. The individual classes will be made up and divided after the cattle are checked in at the show. Any of the classes may be split if classes become too large, at the discretion of show management. They will be judged from the youngest class to the oldest class.
- J. Any animal entered in the Pen Division is eligible to show in the individual classes, and vice versa. They will be required to pay an entry fee for the Open show.
- K. Premiums and Awards: Premiums will be divided equally between Fullblood and Percentage classes and will be paid from the National Western Stock Show offices. Rosettes from the NWSS will be awarded to the Champions and Reserves in each division, as well as GOS, POD and B6H. Banners will be awarded from the NWSS to the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Females, Fullblood Females, Percentage Bulls and Fullblood Bulls, Cow/Calf Fullblood and Percentage. NWSS awards ribbons to winners in each class through 10th place.
- L. American Aberdeen Association will award a Percentage/Purebred and a Fullblood Supreme Champion. The Champion bull, female and cow/calf pair from the above divisions will compete for the Supreme Champion in the division. Fullblood and Percentage/Purebred will not compete against each other.

- 702 Produce-of-Dam—Two animals by one dam shown in the above classes.
- 703 Breeder, Best Six Head—Exhibitor must be the breeder of the animals exhibited in the above classes. Percentage animals must be shown in individual classes.
