1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at livestockentry.nationalwestern.com.
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$60.00 per head, and a \$25.00 per head pre-bedding fee will be added. Free parking is included with entry.
- C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
- D. ACA registration numbers must be stated on entries.

2. Special Rules

- A. Chianina entered must be registered with the American Chianina Association by entry closing date and must be owned and registered in the name of an active member of the ACA or Junior ACA. Both Fullblood and Percentage Chianina will be eligible to show. All entries are subject to the provisions and rules set forth by the Board of Directors of the ACA.
- B. 6.25 % RULE – Animals must have a minimum of 6.25% Chianina blood in order to participate in ACA nationally sponsored shows.
- C. ACA registration papers for each entry must be available for presentation to the Breed Superintendent of the show at the time entries are verified prior to judging. All tattoos will be checked and must correspond with the registration papers. Any animal not having a legible tattoo, or a tattoo not corresponding with its ACA papers, will be ineligible to compete and will be barred from showing.
- D. All animals must be registered with the ACA. Applications for registration will not be considered as valid proof of ownership for the purposes of this show. Original registration papers must be presented to the breed superintendent at check in.
- E. ACA Open Shows—Chianina and Chiangus entries will NOT be entered by designated show classes at the time of nomination. Classes will be broken after all animals are checked in at the show. Individual bull and female classes will be divided into as nearly equal numbers as possible depending on natural age breaks of entries and the total number of animals to be exhibited.
- F. All females eighteen (18) months of age and older must have a certificate of pregnancy from a licensed veterinarian or have produced fertile eggs as certified in a written statement by a licensed veterinarian or embryologist or have a calf at side. There will be a cow/calf class in each division and the class winner will show for Grand Champion. Calves exhibited in the cow/calf division are not allowed to show in individual classes. All cows and calves must be registered with the ACA. The maximum age for calves is 260 days. No maximum age limit on the cows. The registration category of the cow determines the division in which the pair

shows. Calves shown at the cow's side must be the cow's natural calf. The exhibitor may be asked to allow the calf to nurse the cow.

G. All bulls shown in individual classes must have a permanent nose ring and an attached lead

H. Classes will be determined by age, using the futurity system.

407 Junior Get of Sire: Three (3) head by the same sire calved after Sept. 1, 2021. Both sexes represented. All three were exhibited in the individual classes. Need not be owned by the same exhibitor. Sire must be registered with the ACA (excludes commercial or foundation animals).	R
408 Senior Get of Sire: Four (4) head by the same sire. Both sexes represented. All four were exhibited in the individual classes. Need not be owned by the same exhibitor. The sire must be registered with the ACA (excludes commercial or foundation animals).....	R
409 Produce of Dam: Two (2) head produced by the same dam, both were exhibited in the individual classes. Need not be owned by the same exhibitor. The dam must be registered with the ACA (excludes commercial or foundation animals).	R
410 Best Six Head: Six animals owned, co-owned or bred by one exhibitor or by a member of the immediate family. All six were exhibited in the individual classes.	R
