

JUNIOR REGISTERED EWE LAMBS

ENTRIES CLOSE November 20, 2023

1. Entries:
 - A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at livestockentry.nationalwestern.com.
 - B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$25.00 per head. Free parking included with entry.
 - C. Ewes are eligible to show in the Open show as well. Entry must be made for both shows.
 - D. A single participant may enter not more than two (2) ewe lambs in each breed.
2. Special Rules:
 - A. General Rules and Regulations, Health Regulations and Junior Livestock Show Rules and Regulations found in the Livestock Premium List apply to this division as well as those rules listed in each specific division. All Participants must read and abide by these rules.
 - B. Ewe lambs must be registered in the flock book of their respective breed and bear the ear tags of the association before entering the show ring. Ewe lambs must be registered in the individual exhibitor's, sibling or family ownership name prior to November 1, 2023. Wether Sire/Dam ewe lambs and yearlings are eligible for the junior show and showmanship as registration papers are not required. An ownership certificate is required for all Wether Sire/Dam sheep by November 20, 2023.
 - C. Only ewe lambs born on or after January 1, 2023 may be shown and must have all lamb teeth intact.
 - D. Classes offered for Hampshire, Suffolk and Southdown breeds and any other breed with at least ten (10) entries minimum. Classes may be combined if deemed necessary by Stock Show.
 - E. At the discretion of Show Management, classes with larger than twenty (20) animals entered may be divided by age into two (2) classes of approximately equal numbers. Class determination will not be made on single exhibitor with multiple entries. Premiums will be paid in each class.
 - F. Lambs must be shown without coat compounds, including oils, paints, powders, and other dressing. Violation will result in automatic disqualification, with no recourse.
 - G. Substitutions within the same class and same owner only will be accepted. Only one (1) substitution for original animal will be allowed. Substitutions will be allowed after sheep are on NWSS grounds.
 - H. National Western Stock Show awards ribbons to winners in each class through 10th place.
 - I. Jr Market Lambs may stall in barn during Breeding Sheep show if entered with a breeding sheep entry.
 - J. Check-in: Check-in for all breeds/divisions Friday from 1 pm to 3 pm. Must bring registration papers for registered classes and proof of ownership (bill of sale) for Wether Sire Classes. Class corrections will only be made at this time.

Competition will be one showmanship contest for those entering either wool breeds or meat breeds. Exhibitors eligible to show in the Junior Ewe Lamb and Yearling classes are eligible to compete in the Showmanship contest
4. Premiums paid on the Jackpot System
