

**LIMOUSIN PEN SHOW**  
SUPERINTENDENT: Mallory Blunier  
JUDGES: Marty Ropp – Normal, IL  
ENTRIES DUE ONLINE NOVEMBER 20, 2023

1. Entries:
  - A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at [livestockentry.nationalwestern.com](http://livestockentry.nationalwestern.com).
  - B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$105.00 per pen. Yardage fees are \$70.00 per head entered. **Free power and parking are included with entry.**
  - C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store online at [store.nationalwestern.com](http://store.nationalwestern.com) or on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
  - D. NALF registration numbers must be stated on entries.
  - E. Entry deadline is November 20, 2023. Late entries are accepted with additional fees until December 20, 2023.
2. LIMOUSIN Special Rules:
  - A. Bulls competing in the Limousin pen show must be registered and seventy-five percent (75%) Limousin or higher as computed by NALF.
  - B. With the addition of a specific Lim-Flex pen show (see rules below), only one bull per Limousin pen may be 75% Lim-Flex (purple papered). Bulls that are 75% Limousin but do not meet the Lim-Flex criteria are only eligible for the Limousin pen and carload shows (not the Lim-Flex pen show). Lim-Flex 75% bulls must be designated at time of entry as to whether they're being entered in the Lim-Flex pen show or the Limousin pen show.
  - C. Bulls shown in the Limousin pen show cannot show in the carload show or Lim-Flex pen show, but are eligible to enter one (1) bull from the pen to show in the open show on the Hill.
  - D. Alternates: If an alternate for the pen (or Carload) show changes what class the entry will show in, NALF staff must be notified one hour before the show begins. Alternates cannot move a Limousin Pen to the Lim-Flex show or a Lim-Flex pen to the Limousin Show. Bulls out of leased cows are not permitted in the Limousin pen show.
  - E. Premiums: National Western Stock Show offers seven hundred dollars (\$700) of the premium money offered. First place in each individual class will receive premium money to be determined later and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis, through sixth place. All premiums will be mailed directly from the National Western Stock Show offices.
  - F. Classes will be determined by the oldest bull in the pen and according to the following ranges in birth dates:
3. LIM-FLEX Special Rules:
  - A. Two out of the three bulls in the Lim-Flex pen show must be registered as Lim-Flex and have purple registration papers from NALF.
  - B. NALF allows the inclusion of **one** high percentage (NXM) in the Lim-Flex pen bull show. Registered percentage Limousin bulls (orange registration paper) that are not Lim-Flex are not eligible for entry in the Lim-Flex pen show. Lim-Flex 75% bulls must be designated at time of entry as to whether they are being entered in the Lim-Flex pen show or the Limousin pen show.
  - C. In order to meet Lim-Flex registration criteria, animals must be 25 to 75 percent Limousin and

25 to 75 percent Angus or Red Angus, with a maximum allowance of another breed or unknown breed composition of 12.5 percent (1/8th). The sires of registered Lim-Flex animals must be registered with NALF or the sire's respective breed association and have documented pedigree information for both parents. The dams of registered Lim-Flex animals must be documented as from registered sires included in either the NALF herd book or that of another breed association and have actual percent blood information recorded.

- D. Bulls shown in the Lim-Flex pen show cannot show in the Limousin pen or Limousin carload shows but are eligible to show in the open Lim-Flex or Limousin shows on the Hill. If an alternate for the pen show changes what class the entry will show in, NALF staff must be notified one hour before the show begins. Alternates cannot move a Limousin Pen to the Lim-Flex show or a Lim-Flex to the Limousin show. Lim-Flex animals must be out of cows that are in the exhibitor's membership or exhibitor's family membership(s). Animals out of leased cows are not permitted in the Lim-Flex pen show.
- E. Classes will be determined by the oldest bull in the pen and according to the following ranges in birth dates:

- 105 Pen of Three Limousin Bulls (calved February 15 - March 31, 2023)
- 106 Pen of Three Limousin Bulls (calved April 1 - May 31, 2023)
