Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at livestockentry.nationalwestern.com.
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$40.00 per head, and a \$25.00 per head pre-bedding fee will be added. Free parking is included with entry.
- C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store online at store.nationalwestern.com or on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.

2. Special Rules:

- A. All show cattle must have a DNA profile on file with complete parentage verification (dam and sire verification) with the American Hereford Association before show entry deadline.*

This rule will take effect on the following dates:

Steers - effective 1/1/2024

Bulls - effective 1/1/2025

Heifers - effective 1/1/2026

*Please note that DNA verification not completed by the entry deadline for the 2024 National Western Stock Show will be accepted at check-in. This exception only applies to the 2024 NWSS.

- B. All exhibitors must be current members of the MHBA in order to be eligible to show.
- C. Main show contact: Tami Arnold, brandeddesigns@yahoo.com, 970-381-0998
- D. Cattle entered must be registered in the Herd Book of the American Hereford Association. Polled and horned will show together in all miniature classes. Entries with registrations pending, illegible tattoos, or improper tattoos as shown on the registration certificate at check-in time are ineligible for competition. Maximum height at hip to be shown in these classes is 45" on mature females, 48" on mature males. All entries will be measured at check in. Those exceeding the height requirement will be disqualified from competition.
- E. Exhibitors with bulls born before January 1, 2022 in the sale or for sale are required to provide a licensed veterinarian's statement indicating the bull has been semen checked and evaluated as fertile. Semen evaluation is to occur within 90 days of the show. This statement must be

presented at check-in during the National Western Stock Show.

- F. All exhibitors with animals in the sale, please see health requirements for cattle consignment sales in the front of this book.
- G. Classes will be divided after all entries are weighed and measured. Division Champions and Reserves will be chosen from class winners and runner up to champion in classes.
- H. Entries are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the AHA Board of Directors and are subject to supervision of the Show and Sale Committee representing the MHBA and its rules.
- I. All exhibitors must be current members of the MHBA in order to be eligible to show.
- J. Decision of MHBA superintendents will be final. MHBA show superintendents reserve the right to DNA test any animal.
- K. Buckles will be awarded at the MHBA banquet.
- L. Open show prospect and market steer divisions listed in the premium book with the option to break each division into 3 classes. Classes will be divided according to weight after weigh-in.
- M. Premiums: First place in each class will receive one hundred (\$100) dollars and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis among the other animals through 3rd place after the show has been completed. The National Western Stock Show awards ribbons to all winners in each class through eight (8) places; Rosettes to all Division Champions and Reserve Champions and Banners to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.
- N. Premiums Sanctioned by: Miniature Hereford Breeder's Association, which offers \$2000.00 in premium money, American Hereford Association offers \$1000.00 and National Western Stock Show which offers \$3000.00. All premiums will be paid directly from National Western Stock Show offices.

- 401 Pair of Females - two females, bred & owned by the exhibitor. Both must have been entered and
 shown in individual classes.
 Champion and Reserve Champion Pair of Females Rosette
 402 Pair of Bulls - two bulls, bred and owned by the exhibitor. Bulls must have been entered and
 shown in their individual classes.
 Champion and Reserve Champion Pair of Bulls..... Rosette
 403 Get-of-Sire - Three animals by one sire must have been shown in above classes.
 Both sexes represented. All animals must be shown in individual classes.

- 501 Prospect Steers, calved January 1 - December 31, 2023.....A
 Divided into 2 classes after weigh in.
 Champion and Reserve Champion Prospect Steer..... Rosette
 502 Market Steers, calved January 1 - December 31, 2022.....A
 Divided into 2 classes after weigh in.
 Champion and Reserve Champion Market Steer Rosette
