SPECIAL RULES:

- 1. General Rules: General Rules and Regulations, Junior Livestock Show Rules and Regulations, and Auction of Junior Livestock Champions Rules and Regulations found in the Livestock Premium List apply to this division as well as the following special rules. All Participants must read and abide by these rules. This is a NON-TERMINAL show.
- 2. Entries: All entries must be made online by the entry deadline of November 20, 2024
 - A. NO DNA is required for Junior Wether Does. Online entry only at https://nwssrs.fairwire.com/
 - B. NO late entries.
 - C. Signed confirmation receipt of 4-H Extension Agent/FFA Advisor is required.
- 3. Entry Limitation: Participants are permitted to enter up to ten (10) entries but allowed to bring and show no more than four (4). You must pay for all ten (10).
 - A. Exhibitors must be 9-18 years old as of January 1, 2025.
 - B. Exhibitors must be in good standing with 4-H and/or FFA.
 - C. Entries entered in this division must be a doe.
 - D. Doe(s) that have exhibited in the market goat show are not eligible to exhibit in the junior Wether Doe show.
- 4. Animal Identification:
 - A. Scrapie's tags are required for all Junior Wether Does on entries, health papers, and upon arrival to NWSS.
- 5. Official Weight: A weight card provided in exhibitor packets upon arrival to NWSS, must be completed and turned in at processing. This is the official weight and cannot be changed after the weight card has been turned in. The minimum weight for Wether dams is sixty (60) pounds; the maximum weight of one hundred fifty (150) pounds. There is a 5% weigh-back tolerance.
- 6. Grooming:
 - A. All shearing must be done only in a designated area (show ring) before processing. No trim tables can be used after that time, but cordless clippers will be allowed.
 - B. Wether Does cannot use oils, paints, glitters, or other dressings at all while on grounds. Clear adhesive glue will be allowed on the legs only.

C. Horns: If horned, Market Goats must have horns tipped (not less than the diameter of a dime at the end). Tipping of horns is not allowed on the grounds.

7. Showing:

- A. Goats' front feet must be on the floor while showing. The front feet can be picked up to set the animal and then placed back down on the floor.
- B. Participants may use collars or collars with a short lead when showing. No extreme collars (spike/training) will be allowed in the show ring.
- C. Classes will be divided evenly into three divisions, Light, Medium, and Heavy. Champion and Reserve in each Division will compete for Grand and Reserve Champion Wether Doe.
