ENTRIES DUE ONLINE NOVEMBER 20, 2024

1. Entries: All NWSS livestock entries are on line at <https://nwssrs.fairwire.com/>
2. AHA registration numbers must be stated on entries.
 - A. Entry deadline is November 20, 2024. Late entries are accepted with additional fees until December 10, 2024.
3. Special Rules:
 - A. All cattle, including calves on the sides of dams, must be registered in the Herd Book of the American Hereford Association. Entries with registrations "pending" or illegible tattoos, or improper tattoos as shown on the registration certificate at check - in time are ineligible for competition. Exhibitors are subject to the American Hereford Association special rule on class qualification. Entries in these classes are accepted with the understanding that the exhibitor agrees to abide by the rule in all respects.
 - B. The exhibition of cattle displaying false hair will not be allowed.
 - C. Any product administered internally or used externally to alter the conformation of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the use of graphite, hemp or other similar substances externally and steroids or growth stimulants internally.
 - D. The act of artificially filling animals internally, which includes stomach pumping, drench tubes or any other method by mouth or esophagus, is prohibited.
 - E. Expected Progeny Difference (EPD) values will be provided to the judge and audience for all animals shown. Animals without EPD data are eligible to show, but will have N/A (not available) in place of missing data.
 - F. Any animal without a legible tattoo will not be eligible to show.
 - G. All Hereford animals must be officially recorded (registered) prior to show date to be eligible to show at a National Hereford Show.
 - H. Both Horned and Polled Herefords are eligible and will be shown together.
 - I. The individual classes will be made up and divided after the cattle are checked in at the show.
 - J. Exhibitors with senior bull calves, intermediate, yearling & senior bulls are required to provide a licensed veterinarian's statement indicating the bull has been semen checked and evaluated as fertile. Semen evaluation is to occur within 90 days of the show. Exhibitors with females in the spring & junior yearling divisions must be confirmed pregnant within 45 days of show by a licensed veterinarian or by blood test or show with a calf at side. This statement must be presented at check-in during the National Western.
 - K. National Western Stock Show pays all premiums directly from the National Western Stock Show offices.

In Hereford Class carloads may include both Junior and Spring Calves, and in such case, the entry must compete in the junior bull calf class. Carload entries in which all calves are Spring Calves, all calved on or after March 1, 2024 must compete in the spring bull calf class. Competing for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Carloads will be the Champion and Reserve place winners of each division.
