Entries:

A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at https://nwssrs.fairwire.com/.

- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$40.00 per head and a \$25.00 per head pre-bedding fee will be added. Free vehicle parking is included with entry. Trailer Parking is available for a fee at Dicks Sporting Goods Park. Information can be found online at nationalwestern.com
- C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store on the grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.

2. Special Rules:

A. All show cattle must have a DNA profile on file with complete parentage verification (dam and sire verification) with the American Hereford Association before the show entry deadline.

This rule will take effect on the following dates:

Steers - effective 1/1/2024 Bulls - effective 1/1/2025 Heifers - effective 1/1/2026

- B. All exhibitors must be current members of the MHBA in order to be eligible to show.
- C. Main show contact: Tami Arnold, brandeddesigns@yahoo.com, 970-381-0998
- D. Cattle entered must be registered in the Herd Book of the American Hereford Association. Polled and horned will show together in all miniature classes. Entries with registrations pending, illegible tattoos, or improper tattoos as shown on the registration certificate at checkin time are ineligible for competition. The maximum height at the hip to be shown in these classes is 45" for mature females, and 48" for mature males. All entries will be measured at check-in. Those exceeding the height requirement will be disqualified from competition.
- E. Classes will be divided after all entries are weighed and measured. Division Champions and Reserves will be chosen from class winners and runner-up to champion in classes.
- F. Entries are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the AHA Board of Directors and are subject to the supervision of the Show and Sale Committee representing the MHBA and its rules.
- G. All exhibitors must be current members of the MHBA in order to be eligible to show.
- H. The decision of MHBA superintendents will be final. MHBA shows superintendents reserve the right to DNA test any animal.
- I. Open show prospect and market steer divisions listed in the premium book with the option to

- break each division into 3 classes. Classes will be divided according to weight after weigh-in.
- J. Premiums: First place in each class will receive one hundred (\$100) dollars and the remainder of the premium money will be awarded on a graduated basis among the other animals through 3rd place after the show has been completed. The National Western Stock Show awards ribbons to all winners in each class through eight (8) places; Rosettes to all Division Champions and Reserve Champions and Banners to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.
- K. Premiums Sanctioned by: Miniature Hereford Breeder's Association, which offers \$2000.00 in premium money, American Hereford Association offers \$1000.00 and National Western Stock Show which offers \$3000.00. All premiums will be paid directly from National Western Stock Show offices.
- L. Premier exhibitor will be awarded the following point system 1st place = 5 points, 2nd place = 4 points, 3rd place = 3 points, 4th place = 2 points, and 5th place = 1 point. No points will be given for champions. Points will be awarded to Pair of Females and Pair of Bulls for the Premier Exhibitor award.
