- 1) Entries: All NWSS livestock entries are online at https://nwssrs.fairwire.com/.
- a) Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$70.00 per head, and a \$25.00 per head pre-bedding fee will be added. Free parking is included with entry. Free vehicle parking is included with entry. Trailer Parking is available at Dicks Sporting Goods Field for a fee. Information can be found at <u>nationalwestern.com</u>
- All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
- c) ASA registration numbers must be stated on entries.
- 2) Special Rules:
- a) Animals must be registered with the American Simmental Association. Animals competing in the purebred classes must all be registered as Purebred Simmental or Fullblood Simmental. Animals competing in the percentage classes must be at least 1/2 Simmental but less than Purebred Simmental
 - b) This is a Progress Through Performance show, with ASA Ring of Champions points available (see Simmental.org). All data will be printed in the show program and provided to the judge to use in conjunction with a visual appraisal.
 - c) Streamlined Open Show check-in will take place at the breed rep room #116 in the Stockyards Events Center. Exhibitors will be asked to declare which of their entries are on-site and should be checked in for the show, and corresponding back tags will be issued at this time. Do <u>not</u> bring animals to check in. Proof of registration is <u>required</u> at the time of check-in: Original papers, electronic versions or photocopies will be accepted. Any animal not checked in will be considered a scratch. Exhibitors are further expected to meet the following:
 - Any bull fifteen (15) months of age or older must have veterinary proof of a semen test &/or breeding soundness exam and must be proven as a satisfactory breeder.

Any female eighteen (18) months of age or older must be a) certified pregnant by a licensed non-owner veterinarian or b) have certification that she has been used in embryo transfer.

Following the completion of check-in, 10% of the checked-in tattoos will be checked at random. Checks will be performed in the exhibitors' stalls by ASA staff and/or AJSA Trustees. Any animal with a tattoo that does not match its registration will be automatically disqualified from the show. ASA may check additional tattoos and/or papers on any entry.

- d) At check-in, a box will be provided for each exhibitor to nominate up to 2 names for future PTP judges.
- e) Animals that have not been processed will not be eligible to show. Show management reserves the right to bar any animal or exhibitor from showing that does not meet the requirements of this show.
- f) For safety, all animals must be dehorned, and all bulls twelve (12) months of age or older must be shown with a nose lead or ring.
- g) Grand and Reserve Grand Champions will have DNA samples pulled and tested for parental verification and genomics, unless previously tested. DNA collection will occur at the exhibition site and will be supervised and/or conducted by ASA staff. ASA reserves the right to pull DNA on any competing entry. Failure to submit to DNA sampling and/or testing will result in automatic disgualification.
- h) CSA management reserves the right to modify classes as it sees fit, to facilitate a more uniform showing. Division breaks will be determined based on the number of entries. Likewise, classes may be split at CSA's discretion based on entries. If a class is split, premiums also may be split.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to run HD testing on their animals prior to the show. Genomically enhanced i) EPDs are noted in the show program.

PREMIUMS: Premiums will be paid directly from the National Western Stock Show offices. The Colorado Simmental Association offers Champion and Reserve Champion awards.

ACCUMULATED POINTS

PREMIER EXHIBITOR

Premier Exhibitor: Animals must be owned or co-owned by the exhibitor or immediate family member of the exhibitor. Award based on points accumulated in individual classes. 1^{st} place – 5 points, 2^{nd} place – 4 points, 3^{rd} place – 3 points, 4^{th} place – 2 points, $8 5^{th}$ place – 1 point. No points will be given for division or overall champions.

PREMIER BREEDER

Premier Breeder: Animals must be bred or co-bred, but not necessarily owned/co-owned, by a firm or individual or an immediate family member of that firm or individual. Same point system as Premier Exhibitor.....D
