1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at <https://nwssrs.fairwire.com/>.
- B. Entries will be added to base color classes only. Alpacas will be sorted into their respective age group for individual classes. ****YOU MUST ENTER THE SPECIFIC COLOR OF YOUR ALPACA TO COMPLETE YOUR ENTRY.**
- C. **Entry Fees:** Entry fees are as follows and include free parking:
Halter: \$20/animal/class • **Performance:** \$5/participant/class • **Stalls:** \$40/stall. *Stalls are 8' x 10' x 4'. (Two bags of bedding per stall included).* ****An additional \$8/animal/class will be added for AOA show registration fees.****

2. Special Rules:

- A. The Alpaca Show is sponsored by the Alpaca Breeders of the Rockies and entrants must abide by all rules and regulations of the Alpaca Breeders of the Rockies (ABR), Alpaca Owner's Association, Inc. (AOA) and the National Western Stock Show (NWSS).
- B. The Alpaca Halter Show is open to everyone, and the animals must be registered with AOA. The Performance Show is open to all youth (5-18) and adult Alpaca Enthusiasts. Performance Show entrants must be the age listed for the class as of January 1, 2025. The halter show is open to all age groups as defined in the AOA Show System Handbook.
- C. **A LIMITED NUMBER OF STALLS WILL BE AVAILABLE.** Stalls will be assigned by the Show Superintendent on a first-come, first-served basis. The number of stalls per farm is limited to five (5) stalls. The maximum number of Juvenile and Yearling alpacas in stalls is four (4) and Two and older alpacas is three (3). Exhibitors must participate in the halter or performance show to purchase stalls.
- D. Only Alpacas entered in the Halter or Performance Show are allowed on the grounds of the NWSS
- E. Exhibitors should dress appropriately to showcase their Alpaca(s).
- F. **Health Regs:** All Alpacas must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued by a licensed veterinarian in the state of origin within thirty (30) days prior to the date of the show. This

certificate must also show treatment for scabies within thirty (30) days prior to the date of the show. **All Alpacas must be accompanied by a CVI that indicates a negative PCR BVD test.** Alpacas without the proper health certificates will not be allowed on the grounds. **An ARI certification AND Exhibitor Disclosure AND Owner of Record form (if needed) must be emailed to DJ Riedel at show.super.dj@gmail.com.**

- G. Alpacas should be entered in the correct color class (see color class list). Classes will be combined if necessary.
- H. Ribbons will be awarded to the top six (6) places and Banners for Champion, Reserve Champion and Judges Choice for Halter Classes. Ribbons will be awarded to the top six (6) places for Obstacles and Public Relations Classes and Banners for Champion and Reserve Champions for Obstacles and Public Relations. Ribbons for the Costume class will be awarded to the top six (6) places. Championships will only be awarded to classes with 3 or more alpacas. This is a premium payout show based on the Alpaca Show Premium List.

For the Halter Show, age groups are as defined in the AOA Show System Handbook. Championships will only be rewarded to color classes with eight (8) or more huacaya and six (6) or more suri. Alpacas 6 months of age (as of the date of the show) and older may be entered in the Performance Show.

1. **Entries:**

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at livestockentry.nationalwestern.com.
- B. Entries will be added to base color classes only. Alpacas will be sorted into their respective age group for individual classes. ****YOU MUST ENTER THE SPECIFIC COLOR OF YOUR ALPACA TO COMPLETE YOUR ENTRY.**
- C. **Entry Fees:** Entry fees are \$8.00 per fleece. *An additional \$8/fleece/class will be added for AOA show registration fees.*
- D. **Entry Limitations:** No fleece can compete in more than one (1) class except for special prizes. Color categories are: Black, Brown, Fawn, Light (light fawn and beige), White, Grey and Multi. Ages are: (A) 6 months to 12 months (juvenile), (B) First birthday through 24 months (yearling), (C) Second birthday and over.
- E. **Eligibility of Participants:** Any one can participate.
- F. **Eligibility of Fleeces:** In order to be entered in the Alpaca Fleece Show each fleece must have been shorn within the last 380 days per AOA rules, and the alpaca must be registered with AOA.

2. **Special Rules:**

- A. **Purpose:** The purpose of this show is to encourage the production of high-quality alpaca fleece; to promote proper handling, grading and preparation for market; to create an awareness of the many qualities of alpaca fleece and its uses.
- B. Represent no more than twelve (12) months' growth, except in the case of yearling (B) fleeces, when up to sixteen (16) month's growth will be allowed for Huacaya or twenty-four months (24) for Suri.
- C. The Alpaca Fleece Show Coordinator reserves the right to inspect any fleece entered to determine its eligibility and color placement.

3. **Qualifications:** Any fleece entered for competition shall be judged per AOA fleece show rules.

4. **Preparation of Fleeces:** All fleeces shall be rolled cut side out in a manner to allow their being handled without falling apart. It is recommended that exhibitors pack fleeces rather loosely in clear plastic bags so as not to impair their character or attractiveness.

- A. Each bag of fleece must contain a completed "Alpaca Fleece Show Entry Tag" a copy of the ARI certificate and the completed Exhibitor Disclosure form. These tags will be available thru the ABR website, www.alpacabreeders.org. **Any help needed to fill these out, contact DJ Riedel, 303-886-7810, show.super.dj@gmail.com.**
- B. Fleeces must be delivered to the show on January 23, 2025 between 12:00 Noon and 5:00 PM. E-mails will alert you to other drop-off areas. Mailed in fleeces will be accepted if received by January 20, 2025.
- C. Fleeces will be released for pick-up Saturday, January 25, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. Participants may pick up fleeces at the stock show or must make arrangements with Rick Harmsen.

- D. In the case of any controversy relative to the classification of any fleece offered in exhibition, affidavits from the Participants may be required. However, in all such controversies involving any interpretation of these rules and regulations, the decision of a committee consisting of the Alpaca Fleece Show Coordinator, the Alpaca Fleece Show Judge and the National Western Stock Show Management shall be final.
- E. The Alpaca Fleece Show Coordinator reserves the right to combine classes if the number of entries in any individual class does not warrant a separate class and to place entries in appropriate classes and divisions as necessary.
- F. All fleeces will be displayed in clear plastic bags. Noodling is accepted.
- G. The Alpaca Breeders of the Rockies, Inc., Alpaca Owner's Association, Inc., and the National Western Stock Show Association are not responsible for fleeces entered in the Alpaca Fleece Show.
