1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at https://nwssrs.fairwire.com/.
- **B.** Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$40.00 per head and a \$25.00 per head pre-bedding fee will be added. Free vehicle parking is included with entry. Trailer parking is available for a fee at Dick's Sporting Goods Park. Information is available online at nationalwestern.com
- C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store on the grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.

2. Special Rules:

- A. Classes are open to 3/4 blood, 7/8 blood, Purebred, and Fullblood females; and to 7/8 blood, Purebred, and Fullblood bulls. The animals must be registered with the NASDA. Registration certificates must be presented at the time of check-in at the National Western Stock Show. EPDs will be provided in the show program and also to the judges for consideration in placing classes.
- **B.** Original registration certificates must be presented to NASDA show officials at the time of tattoo inspection. All animals must have a clear, legible tattoo that includes the herd prefix and the year letter designation. The tattoo must correspond to the registration certificate or the animal will be disqualified.
- **C.** All females born prior to April 30, 2023, must be accompanied by a veterinarian's statement of pregnancy within thirty (30) days of the show or a statement that the animal has already calved or that fertilized eggs have been recovered by an ova transplant facility.
- **D.** Cattle are to be shown in their natural conformation. The use of false tailheads other use of color-altering adhesives or paint or adding hair or other materials to any part of the animal's body is prohibited.
- E. There will be five thousand two hundred (\$5,200) dollars in prize funds offered. The NASDA offers two thousand six hundred (\$2,600) dollars of the premiums and the National Western Stock Show offers two thousand six hundred (\$2,600) dollars of the premiums. All checks will be mailed directly from the National Western Stock Show offices. National Western Stock Show awards ribbons to winners in each class through 10th place.

SOUTH DEVON GROUPS

Only one Poundmaker per class, except for Get-of-Sire and the Best Five Head two Poundmakers are allowed.

Two Bulls - Bred and owned by an exhibitor. Must be shown in individual classes (201 to 212) to be eligible
Pair of Calves - Two (2) calves, both sexes to be represented. Bred and owned by exhibitor. Must be shown in individual classes (101 to 106 and 201 to 206) to be eligible and must also be shown in individual classes
Pair of Yearlings - Two (2) yearlings, both sexes to be represented. Bred and owned by an exhibitor. Must be shown in individual classes (107 to 110 and 207 to 210) to be eligible and must also be shown in individual classes
Produce of Dam - Two (2) animals, either sex, from one (1) dam. May be owned by more than one (1) exhibitor. Must be shown in individual classes to be eligibleB
Junior Get-of-Sire - Three (3) calves, calved after September 1, 2016. All by one (1) sire, both sexes to be represented. May be owned by more than one (1) exhibitor. All animals must be shown in individual classes to be eligible

- **707** Group of Five Five (5) Head, both sexes represented, owned in part or all by the exhibitor, including immediate family ownership such as children or grandchildren, and shown in any of the individual classes to be eligible and shown in any of the individual classes to be eligible ... B

PREMIER EXHIBITOR

Points will be awarded to the person entering and exhibiting the animal including immediate family ownership such as children or grandchildren, with the winner being determined by the individual animal's placement within individual classes with the maximum number of placements being limited to five (5). Points allowed are three (3) for 1st in class, two (2) for 2nd in class, and one (1) for 3rd in class. In addition, three (3) points will be awarded for Grand Champions and two (2) points for Reserve Grand Champions. No points are awarded to division champions or reserves. In case of a tie, additional placements beyond five (5) will be used until a winner is determined. Multiple ownerships will be considered as a separate entry of their own.

PREMIER BREEDER

Exhibitors in contention are the registered breeders of record or immediate family members with the same prefix, this includes children or grandchildren, with the winner being determined by the individual animal's placement within individual classes, and the maximum number of placements being limited to five (5). Points allowed are three (3) for 1st in class, two (2) for 2nd in class and one (1) for 3rd in class. In addition, three (3) points will be awarded for Grand Champions and two (2) points for Reserve Grand Champions. No points will be allowed for division champions or reserves. In case of a tie, additional placements beyond five (5) will be used until a winner is determined. Multiple breeders will be considered as a separate entry of their own.

POUNDMAKER SHOW

To qualify to show in the percentage South Devon Show, the females need to be 25% - 74.9% South Devon and the bulls 25%-87.4% South Devon. The age classification would be the same as the purebred show. The same entry rules and premiums would apply for the Poundmaker show that now apply for the open show and would run concurrently with the open show.

1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at livestockentry.nationalwestern.com.
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$35.00 per head. Free parking included with entry.
- C. Heifers are eligible to show in the Open show as well. Entry must be made for both shows.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.

2. Special Rules:

- **A.** Classes are open to 3/4 blood through fullblood females and all animals will show together. The animals must be owned by the exhibitor, who must be a Junior Association Member of the North American South Devon Association in good standing with no monies owed to the Association. All animals must be registered with the NASDA prior to November 1, 2024.
- **B.** The North American South Devon Association offers one-half of premiums offered (\$500). National Western Stock Show offers one-half of premiums (\$500). All premiums will be paid directly from National Western Stock Show offices.
- **C.** All females born on or prior to April 30, 2023 must be accompanied by a veterinarian's statement issued within thirty (30) days of the show stating that the animal is pregnant, or by a statement from an embryo transfer facility saying that fertilized eggs have been recovered.
- D. Poundmaker Division: To qualify to show in the percentage South Devon Show, the females need to be 25% 74.9% South Devon and the bulls 25%-87.4% South Devon. The age classification would be the same as the purebred show. The same entry rules and premiums would apply for the poundmaker show that now apply for the open show and would run concurrently with the open show.
- E. Any heifer that is dual registered may enter and show in both the Junior and Open breeding divisions for those respective breeds. A separate entry fee must be paid for both breed shows.
