 - B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$100.00 per dog. Free parking is included with entry.
- 2. Special Rules:
 - A. Two (2) dogs per handler, per class. If entries exceed the limit, a random draw may be conducted to fill the appropriate classes.
- 3. The Open Cattle Stock Dog Trial will be open to fifty (50) dogs for the qualifying rounds. The top 20 dogs from the qualifying rounds will advance to the Open Cattle Finals. (The top 3 5 dogs (depending on the number of entries) from each qualifying run will automatically be qualified for
