1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at <https://nwssrs.fairwire.com/>.
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$65.00 per head (including entry and admin fees), and a \$25.00 per head pre-bedding fee will be added. **Free power and vehicle parking are included with entry. Trailer Parking is available at Dicks Sporting Goods Field for a fee. Information is available at nationalwestern.com**
- C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.

2. Special Rules:

- B. All entries must be registered or eligible to be registered with the AGBA.
- C. Classes listed are general classifications only. The individual classes will be determined and divided after the cattle are checked in at the show.
- D. All entries will be weighted and measured (hip height, feet set by handler's approval of placement) at check-in, any animals not processed will not be eligible to show. To minimize variation in data collection, one individual will collect data on all entries. After animals have left initial processing, they may be re-measured once with the payment of \$25 per head at the time of re-measurement. The second measurement is final and will replace the original measurement. Re-measurement will only be done at the conclusion of regular processing.
- E. Substitutions may only be made with entries of the same sex and class; and to be submitted to the superintendent, no later than Jan. 10th.
- F. Premiums TBD based on the number of entries in each class.
- G. National Western Stock Show awards ribbons to winners in each class through 5th place, rosettes to all Division Champions and Reserve Champions, and banners to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.

Percentage Classes: To be eligible to show in Galloway Percentage Show animals must have one registered Galloway parent. Either the sire or the dam of the entry must be 100% Galloway registered with the AGBA. The show is governed by the same rules as the Galloway Show.

- I. Premier Breeder: Awarded to the Breeder of Record, regardless of current ownership of entry,

with the highest total points. Point system same as Premier Exhibitor.

- J. Herdsman Award: Ballot voting by exhibitors at cattle check-in. One ballot per exhibitor is allowed. The tiebreaker will be chosen by the superintendent.
- K. Carcass Champion: Awarded to the top combined ultrasound data.

AGBA YOUTH SHOW

Animals exhibited must be registered with the AGBA, but are not required to be exhibited in the Galloway Open show. *Junior classes will follow the same class breakout and entries shall be identified with a prefix ("Jr"). Example- {Jr101-Youth Class -Heifers calved after July 1, 2024.}
