## Entry Rules & Regulations:

### Entry Information:

1. General Rules and Regulations apply to this division as well as those rules listed below.
2. All NWSS livestock entries can be made online at [nationalwestern.com](http://nationalwestern.com).
3. Entry fees are \$100 per pen with no yardage or pre-bedding fee. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store online at [store.nationalwestern.com](http://store.nationalwestern.com) or on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
4. All entries must be in their assigned pens no later than the date and time specified in the Arrival and Release Schedule

### Special Rules:

5. Commercial females to be judged by a panel of 3 judges
6. Commercial females to be shown on soundness, quality, conformation and their usefulness as replacement heifers. The intent of this show is for commercial oriented heifers.
7. Heifers will be shown as sets of 5 or sets of 10 heifers with divisions broken as shown below in the class list.
8. Exhibitor is allowed one (1) alternate heifer per load and may sell with load. Females entered in this division cannot be entered in any other division of the show.
9. For each entry consignors must present a health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian stating that the heifers are open or bred. Certificate must be issued within fourteen (14) days prior to the show and sale. Heifers will be pregnancy checked at the sellers' expense. Seller represents heifers as they are for current and future breeding purposes. All guarantees are between the seller and buyer. All health certificates must be turned in upon arrival and must state that the animals have or have not been implanted and/or vaccinated. Four (4) copies of each are required. All heifer calves must be officially calfhood vaccinated for brucellosis (official vaccination tags must be intact), show a negative BVD-PI test and treated for scabies, with proof of such submitted with health certificate. (Refer to Health Requirements in front of Livestock Premium List)
10. CONSIGNORS MUST SUBMIT INFORMATION ON THE PROVIDED FORM AND SUBMIT IT WITH THE ENTRY FORM FOR THE SALE CATALOG PREPARATION.
11. Females will be judged, (removal of manure, mud or bedding acceptable). Torching or singeing of heifers will be accepted.
12. A champion and reserve will be picked in each division. An overall champion will be selected.
13. All Commercial Females will be weighed prior to show.
14. Commercial Females will be sold in order of placings on Sunday, January 7th Commission of eight (8%) percent of gross sales will be charged for Live Cattle Sold. Refer to Rules and Regulations item listed as National Western Stock Show Livestock Sales. Any purchase not announced in the Auction Ring as a "No Sale" must be paid for by check by the consignor.

14. Premiums: Some premium money and ribbons will be offered by the National Western Stock Show. An incentive of \$100.00 per pen will be paid to those shown.
