Entry Rules & Regulations:

Entry Information:

- 1. All NWSS livestock entries can be made online at nationalwestern.com.
- 2. Entry Fees are \$25.00 per head. Free vehicle parking is included with entry. Trailer parking is available for a fee at Dicks Sporting Goods Park. Information can be found at nationalwestern.com.
- 3. Ewes are eligible to show in the Open show as well. Entry must be made for both shows.
- 4. A single participant may enter not more than two (2) ewe lambs in each breed.

Special Rules:

- 5. General Rules and Regulations, Health Regulations and Junior Livestock Show Rules and Regulations found in the Livestock Premium List apply to this division as well as those rules listed in each specific division. All Participants must read and abide by these rules.
- 6. Ewe lambs must be registered in the flock book of their respective breed and bear the ear tags of the association before entering the show ring. Ewe lambs must be registered in the individual exhibitor's, sibling or family ownership name prior to December 10, 2025. Wether Sire/Dam ewe lambs and yearlings are eligible for the junior show and showmanship as registration papers are not required. An ownership certificate is required for all Wether Sire/Dam sheep by December 10, 2025.
- 7. Only ewe lambs born on or after January 1, 2025 may be shown and must have all lamb teeth intact.
- 8. Classes are offered for Hampshire, Suffolk and Southdown breeds and any other breed with a ten (10) entry minimum. Classes may be combined if deemed necessary by National Western Stock Show management.
- 9. The Wetherdam division will be shown by weight only. Official weight will be taken at check-in and classes will be broken off that weight. Maximum weight for wetherdams is 275 pounds.
- 10. At the discretion of Show Management, classes with larger than twenty (20) animals entered may be divided by age into two (2) classes of approximately equal numbers. Class determination will not be made on single exhibitor with multiple entries. Premiums will be paid in each class.
- 11. Lambs must be shown without coat compounds, including oils, paints, powders, and other dressing. Violation will result in automatic disqualification, with no recourse.
- 12. Substitutions within the same class and same owner only will be accepted. Only one (1) substitution for the original animal will be allowed. Substitutions will be allowed after sheep are on NWSS grounds.
- 13. Jr Market Lambs may stall in barn during Breeding Sheep show if entered with a breeding sheep entry.
- 14. Check-in: Check-in for all breeds/divisions Friday from 1 pm to 3 pm. Participants must bring registration papers for registered classes and proof of ownership (bill of sale) for Wether Sire Classes. Class corrections will only be made at this time.

- 4. Meat Breed Showmanship will take place prior to the Jr Ewe Meat Breeds show and Wool Breed Showmanship will take place prior to the Jr Ewe Wool Breeds show.
