They are fully vaccinated with Vista Once and 7 Way boosters, 2 rounds of Endovac, and boosted with a Nasalgen3 vaccine at weaning. They have received Ivermectin pour-on.

Heifers are out of Limflex & SimAngus cross cows by Angus, SimAngus and Limflex Bulls. Raised above 6500 feet elevation.
